Action Items:

1. Glenn to look into MOST schedule and timeline.

4. Status of 405C Projects
 - A. 2018 Projects - Two contracts have been completed (Aurora and Trinidad).
 - i. Canon City needs time to complete the software, and would like to push their project into next year.
 - ii. CSP had a late start on their project, but they expect to work for a month.
 - B. 2019 Projects -mostly comprise of 3 large projects; \$600,000 is still unplanned.
 - i. Projects could still be started in the fall, but they must be completed by September 30th.

5. NGA Learning Lab
 - A. Charles Meyer sent out the report.
 - B. The idea of this was to get the data into the hands of those who need it, and link data sources together.
 - C. CDOT's new BESDT program will aid in data accessibility and integration.
 - D. DAISY will help link CDOT data sources.

Action Items:

4. Lindsay to present at the next STRAC meeting on DOR's response to the NGA Learning Lab.
5. Christine and Glenn to attend next NGA meeting.
6. Glenn to send contacts for the emphasis areas of the SHSP to Alisa and the Aging Driver contact to Christine.

- E. CSP is looking into an Excel based data system to go along with Niche.

6. BESDT update
 - A. OIT is developing the BESDT program for CDOT.
 - i. The BESDT developers need the data mapping for the DR3447 from DOR.
 - ii. It will be January before the specs on the 3447 will be available.
 - iii. It will be January or February before DRIVES can start accepting the new reports.
 - iv. BESDT will include a fatal blotter database
 - v. CDOT has released the first half of 2017 crash records and is working on second half.
7. DRIVES Update, E-crash & Missing Records
 - A. DRIVES went live with vehicle data on August 6th. They are now working out the kinks.
 - i. Duplicate records are being entered into the system. DOR is working on this as well.
 - ii. DOR is working with CSP to get Crash records.
 - B. The DR3447 and E-Citation projects will be the priority in their next steps.
 - C. DOR wants to use up printed DR 2447 forms
 - D. Due to the latest DRIVES rollout, Denver PD is not submitting e-crash test records at this time.
 - i. Of the approximately 6000 missing Denver records, about 2000 were private property and counter reports.
8. TRC Update
 - A. Minor corrections on the DR3447 are complete.
 - i. Lane position has been clarified.
 - ii. The “number of traffic units” box has been fixed.
 - iii. Minor oversights on the overlay have been corrected.
 - iv. The difference between interstate trucks and in-state only trucks has been clarified.
 - B. Motion to accept these changes.
 - i. Moved by Maj. Santos, second by Christine. Unanimously approved.
 - C. Many agencies will only submit the DR3447 crash form once they are able to do so electronically.
 - i. An online portal form could help agencies to submit electronically.
 - ii. There will be an overlap with the new and old forms being used simultaneously for a short time.
 - iii. Information from DOR on a regular basis will help local law enforcement agencies (LLE) make a smooth transition between forms.
 - iv. LLE forums could provide valuable feedback on the DR3447 manual.
 1. A webinar might be the best early form for this training.
 2. Town hall style meetings/workshops could follow.
 3. Trainers, people at academies, and traffic people should be the first participants.
 - D. Trainers have provided feedback that training on the new crash form should be 3 days instead of 2.
 - i. Feedback has also been received that suggests that training officers should be developing the training based on criteria that STRAC provides them, and doing the actual training on the new form.
 - ii. It was discussed that STRAC could provide a video outlining the changes made to the new form.
 - iii. The Colorado Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) should be coordinated with on this project.
 - E. NHTSA has completed a review of each states MMUCC compliance.
 - i. It is unclear whether they used the DR2447 or DR3447 for their model.
 - ii. NHTSA could reexamine the compliance using the DR3447 form if need be.
 - F. Data problems and solutions will be rolled into the RFI.

7. The TRC will set up a webinar with stakeholders on the 3447 Manual.
8. Glenn will schedule a meeting with POST to include Maj. Santos, Alisa and Crystal.
9. Mike Close will look into whether NHTSA used the DR2447 or DR3447 for their MMUCC review.
10. Paul to send the TRC info on the Michigan’s Traffic Crash Data Quality Control Measures.
11. The TRC will look into more states in their RFI investigation.

9. Traffic Records Forum (TRF)
 - A. Dave - Attended a roundtable on STRACs.
 - i. Ryan’s presentation on the new crash form transition was a big hit; as was Becky’s dui and marijuana presentations.
 - ii. Glad we used MMUCC as our model for self-driving vehicles.
 - iii. Future emphasis will be on making the roadway smarter, not just the cars, to reduce costs.
 - B. Ryan - The forum was well attended.
 - i. Data integration was the main theme.
 - C. Joe - Roundtables and ATSIP board meetings focused on data integration.
 - i. MIRE elements and Highway Safety Manual are being pushed out.
 - D. Paul - Connected vehicles were a big theme, as was data integration.
 - i. Attended a session on the ANSI D-16
 - ii. Concluded that Colorado is doing well when compared to other states.
 - E. Mike - Agrees with the previous statements.
 - F. Becky - Realizes that data visualization is important.
 - i. Lots of buy in from data collectors on the new crash form.

10. October STRAC meeting

- A. STRAC Officer nominations and elections will take place at the next STRAC meeting.
- B. The next two STRAC meetings will be held at CSP in room M1
- C. The schedule will remain the same for 2019 (3rd Thursday of even numbered months).

 - iii. Would like to see if CSP can overlay speed data with crash data.
 - iv. Role of CDOT, CSP, and DOR will be discussed
- D. Crystal - Benjamin Mitchell is the new director of Driver Control; he is on the DUI Commission.
 - i. And plans to attend STRAC meetings when possible.
 - ii. Lindsay Markham will be taking on more of a roll in STRAC.
- E. Alisa - More data on autonomous vehicles is coming.
 - i. CDOT is looking into technology to be out in front of this.
 - ii. Some things that may help in this are the DAISY data warehouse, using roadway data.
 - iii. Exploring if Google can help geo-locate off system crashes.
