Action Requested - Funding

• Establish FY 2014 Start-Up Fund (\$10.9M)

• Unallocated FASTER Statewide Transit funds (\$5.5M)

• Unallocated SB 1 Transit funds (\$5.4M)

× Includes FREX bus sale proceeds & escrow (\$500K)

• Authorize \$3.0M/year for IX O&M and capital needs

- o Source FASTER Statewide Transit
- Supplemented by fare box revenue
- o Establish IX Reserve Fund (\$3.0M ceiling)
 - × Commission controlled

Action Requested – FY 2014 Expenditures

- Purchase 13 Over-the-Road Coaches (\$7.8M est)
- Contract with a private operator (\$5.85M est)
 - 3 year contract w/ 2 one-year options
 - Funded through FY 2015-17 FASTER Statewide Transit (\$3.0M)
- Park-and-Ride improvements (\$1.0M est)
- Misc capital (\$250K if needed)
- Misc operating costs (\$280K est)
 - Communications plan/branding
 - Compliance engineer
- IX Reserve (\$1.57M est)

Action Requested – Other Elements

- Designate T&I Committee as IX Operations Committee
- Opening day Late 2014/Early 2015
 As soon as fleet is available
- Three year operation assessment
 - Monitor performance/success throughout
 - At 3 year mark, ability to continue, modify or cancel

Fort Collins to DUS

- 5 round trips/wkday
 - 4 peak commute times
 - 1 off-peak
- Park-and-Rides/stations
 - I-25/Harmony Road PNR
 - × Park-and-ride expansion required
 - I-25/US 34 PNR
 - Denver Union Station
- Utilize current/future managed lanes & direct DUS access
- Ridership estimate
 - o 171-257 passengers/day



Colorado Springs to DUS

- 6 round trips/wkday
 - 5 peak commute times
 - o 1 off-peak
- Park-and-Rides/stations
 - I-25/Tejon Rd PNR
 - o I-25/Woodman Rd PNR
 - × Park-and-ride access required
 - o I-25/Monument PNR
 - o I-25/Broadway Station
 - Denver Union Station
- Ridership estimate
 - 371-556 passengers/day



Mountain Corridor Plan

- 1 round trip/wkday
 - 7:20AM depart Glenwood Springs
 - o 6:00PM depart DUS
- Park-and-Rides/stations
 - South Glenwood Station PNR
 - o I-70/Eagle PNR
 - Vail Transit Center PNR (pay in winter)
 - Frisco Transit Center PNR
 - Denver Federal Center
 - Denver Union Station
- Ridership estimate
 - o 18-36 Passengers/day
