



# Task Force Overview


- Legislation requires:
  - Commission shall establish a distribution formula for the local portion.
  - Distribution formula based on population and transit ridership.
  - Distribution formula must be developed in consultation with the:
    - ❖ Transit and Rail Advisory Committee (TRAC)
    - ❖ Statewide Transportation Advisory Committee (STAC)
    - ❖ Transit Advocacy Organizations
    - ❖ Bicycle and Pedestrian Advocacy Organizations





# Task Force Overview

- Additional Considerations: SB 1 Multimodal Options Funding Legislative Declaration
  - Legislation states that a complete and integrated multimodal system that:
    - ❖ Benefits seniors by making aging in place more feasible
    - ❖ Benefits residents of rural areas by providing them with flexible public transportation services
    - ❖ Provides enhanced mobility for persons with disabilities
    - ❖ Provides safe routes to school for children





# Committee Membership

  - STAC (Urban and Rural) - *Required*
  - TRAC - *Required*
  - CASTA (Transit Advocacy and Rural Public Transit) - *Required*
  - Bicycle Colorado (Bicycle Advocacy) - *Required*
  - WalkDenver (Walking Advocacy) - *Required*
  - Colorado Commission on Aging (Aging in Place)
  - Safe Routes to School Committee Representative (Safe Routes to School)
  - Colorado Advisory Council for People with Disabilities (Enhanced mobility for Persons with Disabilities)



# Roles and Responsibilities

---

- Committee Roles and Responsibilities
  - ❖ Advise the Transportation Commission on the distribution formula
  - ❖ Advise TC on Match Requirements (or exceptions)
