Instructing the Colorado Department of Transportation to dedicate revenue received through Senate Bill 17-267 towards the approved project list enclosed.

Approved by the Transportation Commission on August 20, 2020.

WHEREAS, the Colorado Legislature provided transportation funding through Senate Bill 17-267 and the Colorado Transportation Commission approved the strategic transit project list in December 2019 via resolution TC 2019-12-3; and

WHEREAS, the Colorado Transportation Commission provided direction for the selection of additional capital transit projects to be funded with the remainder of FY 2019 and FY 2020 through 2022 Senate Bill 17-267 funds; and

WHEREAS, five local projects were awarded through the Division of Transit and Rail's 2020 Consolidated Capital Call for Projects (CCCP) in March 2020; and

WHEREAS, two additional projects were added and authorized which provide matching funds for the competitive Federal grant programs CRISI and BUILD, via the Transportation Commission's Mobility System's Committee, and resolution TC 20-04-03; and

WHEREAS, the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) identified five additional transit projects through the statewide planning process totaling \$10,709,504; and

WHEREAS, three of the previously approved SB 267 transit projects require budget adjustments, resulting in a net reduction of <\$755,004>.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Colorado Transportation Commission approves the following list of transit projects for FY 2018-2020 in accordance with stipulations provided by law:
