Mask Policy Update Starting September 7 (Announced 8/31)

Starting Sept. 7, CDOT will require masks in all indoor public spaces, regardless of vaccination status

Colorado’s latest surge in COVID-19 cases driven by the Delta variant has challenged existing response measures and proven that we all need to work together to help protect one another by reducing transmission and slowing the spread of the virus.

With that in mind, CDOT Executive Management has made the decision to bring back indoor mask requirements for public spaces at all CDOT facilities. **Starting September 7th, all CDOT employees will be required to wear masks in indoor public spaces and situations where social distancing is not possible, regardless of vaccination status. You may still remove your mask when you are seated at your individual workstation if you can maintain social distancing from other employees or visitors (i.e., more than 6 feet of separation).**

Public spaces in CDOT facilities include, but are not limited to: restrooms, social areas (lobbies, reception areas, social hubs), conference and meeting rooms, building hallways, corridors and stairwells, breakrooms, elevators and CDOT fleet vehicles and equipment (when multiple people are present in that vehicle).

As we readjust to mask wearing for the time being, we know that there will be a lot of judgment calls about which spaces qualify as public versus private spaces, and please remember to communicate and be respectful of your colleagues in making those judgment calls. Please err on the side of checking with your office mates on their respective comfort level as you share space.
