Introduction & Welcome of Participants

The meeting was called to order and a roll-call attendance was taken to identify all
participants on the call based on the first meeting.

Categorical Exclusion

- The CDOT and KDOT environmental teams have been working hard.
- A meeting was held July 3rd to cover some details for both environmental teams.
- CDOT and KDOT teams provided their draft Cat Ex materials 7/17 and 7/10, respectively.
- David has integrated the two teams' information as of today and will send for review.
- FRA agreed that they do not want to receive draft materials until all others have done review and the full Cat Ex document is ready to be transmitted to FRA.
- Target schedule is:
 - David sends draft Cat Ex 7/23,
 - Reviews are completed by BNSF, CDOT, KDOT by 7/30



- David compiles reviews and transmits Cat Ex to FRA by Wednesday 7/31
- FRA expects an approximately one month turn-around, Friday 8/30

Grant Agreements / Contracts / Funding Commitments

- FRA transmitted a copy of the T&C, Scope of Work, Schedule, Budget, and Performance Measures to CDOT today.
- CDOT should review and edit in "track changes." CDOT may return comments in pieces, rather than waiting to complete review of all sections.
- CDOT will have a draft of the agreement to send to the parties soon.
- [post call] Amtrak has re-thought their approach and thinks it will be faster to do two agreements, one with BNSF on standard terms, and one with CDOT for additional terms. In addition to efficiency, that will avoid "flow down" conflicts between Federal and State language.

Engineering

- FRA needs to sign-off on the Cat Ex before pre-award authority is granted. The authority will enable BNSF to incur costs, but billing/invoicing/reimbursement will not occur until the final FRA-CDOT agreement is signed.
- BNSF will complete engineering design as soon as possible, after the pre-award is given. The inability to invoice, until final agreement is signed, is agreeable to and understood by BNSF. It still helps the readiness for construction, and the ability to be ready to order materials upon full award.

Summary / Next Steps

- David sends draft Cat Ex 7/23,
- Reviews are completed by BNSF, CDOT, KDOT by 7/30
- David compiles reviews and transmits Cat Ex to FRA by Wednesday 7/31
- Megan Kelly from CDOT will work with Amtrak, BNSF, KDOT, and SWC&FRPRC in the meanwhile.
