

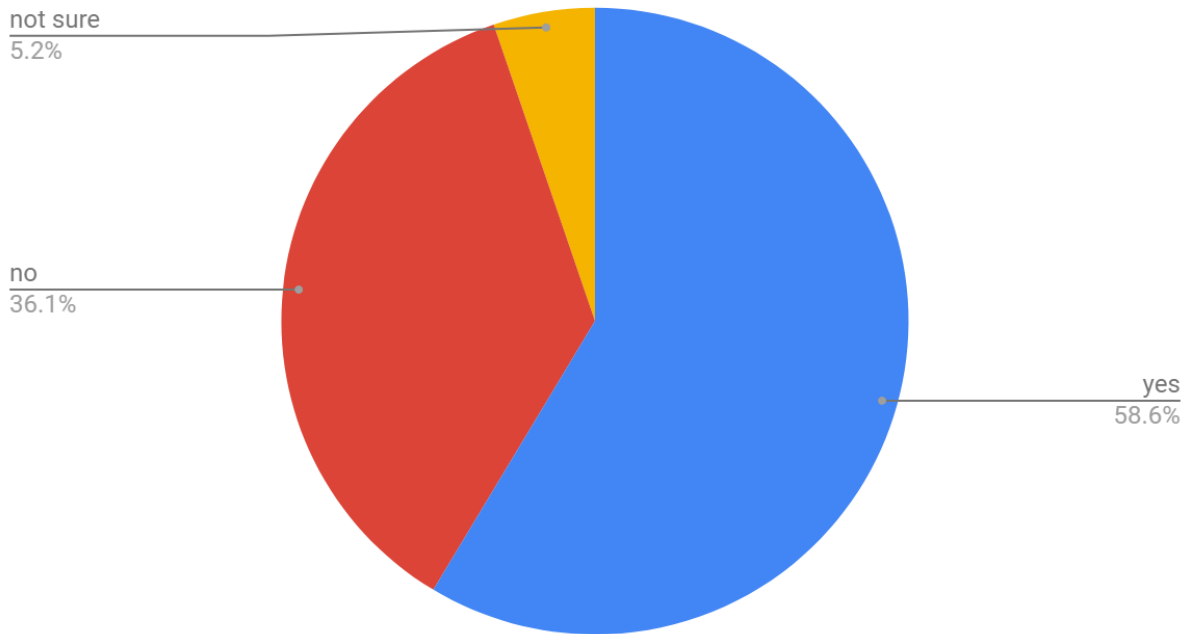

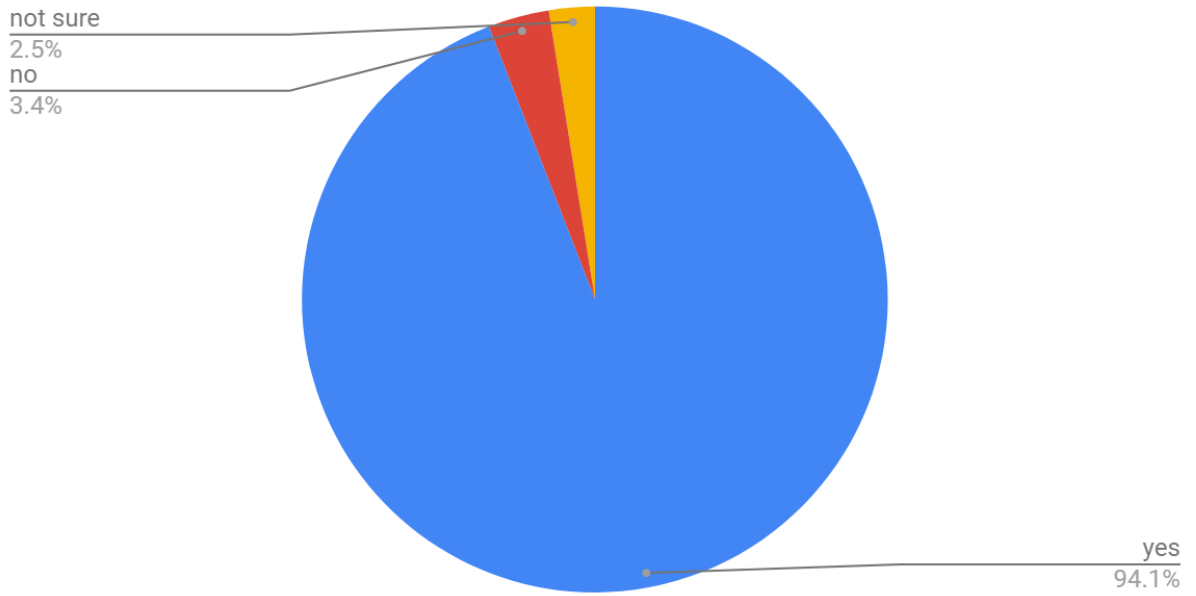

Are you aware of of the Front Range Passenger Rail study?



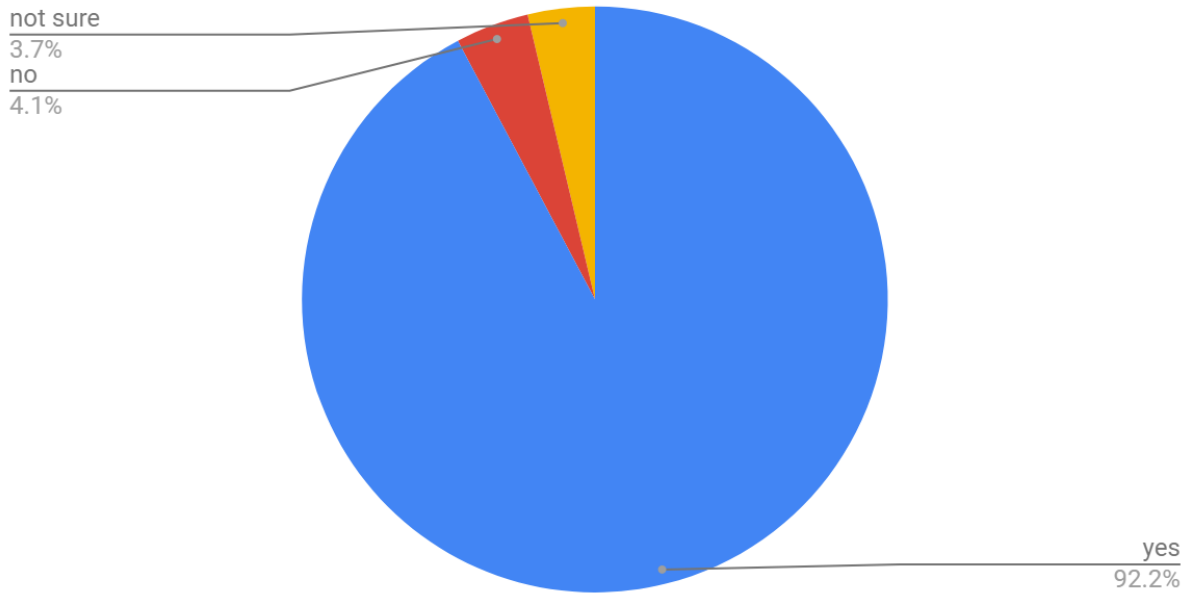

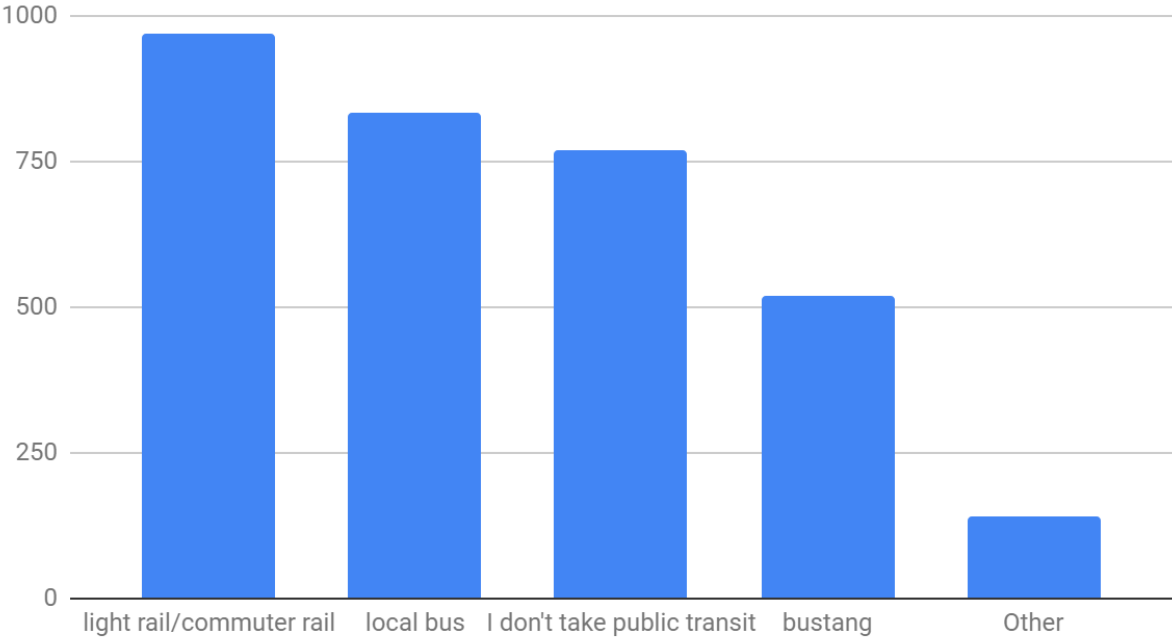
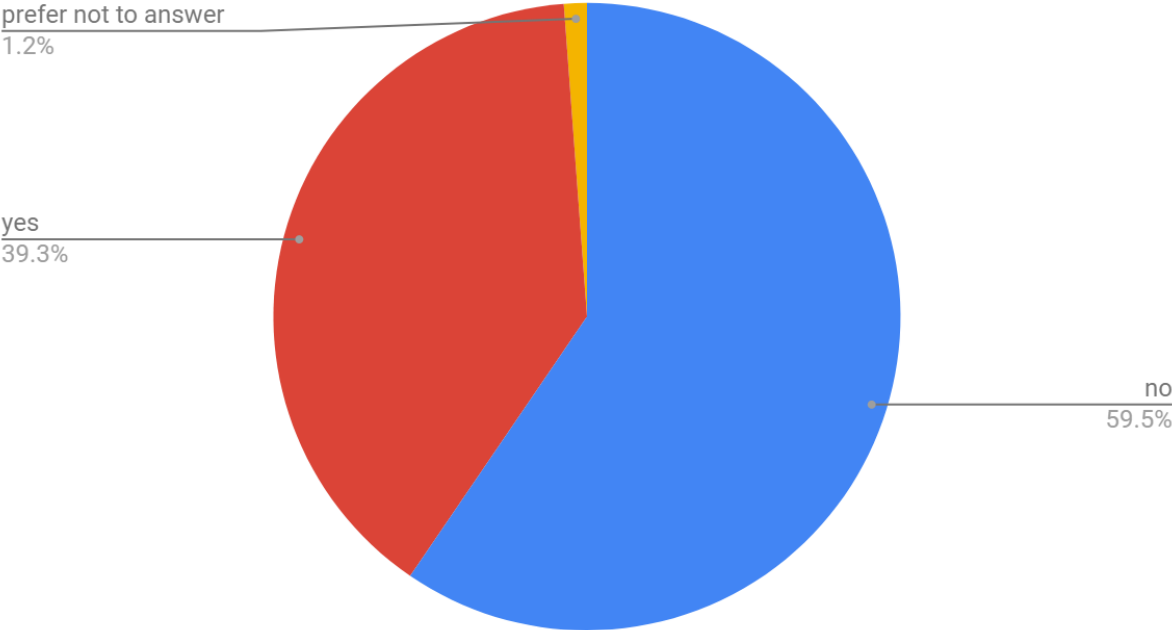

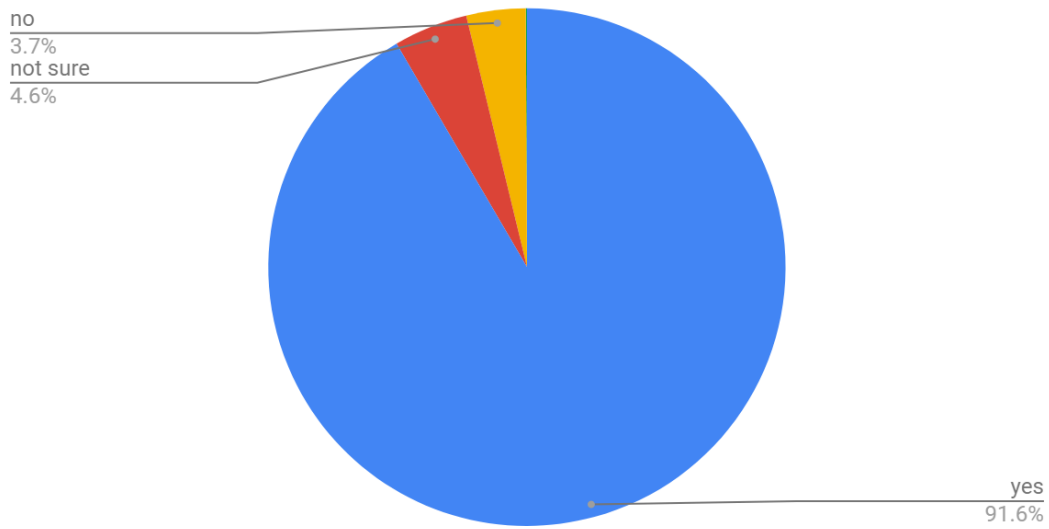

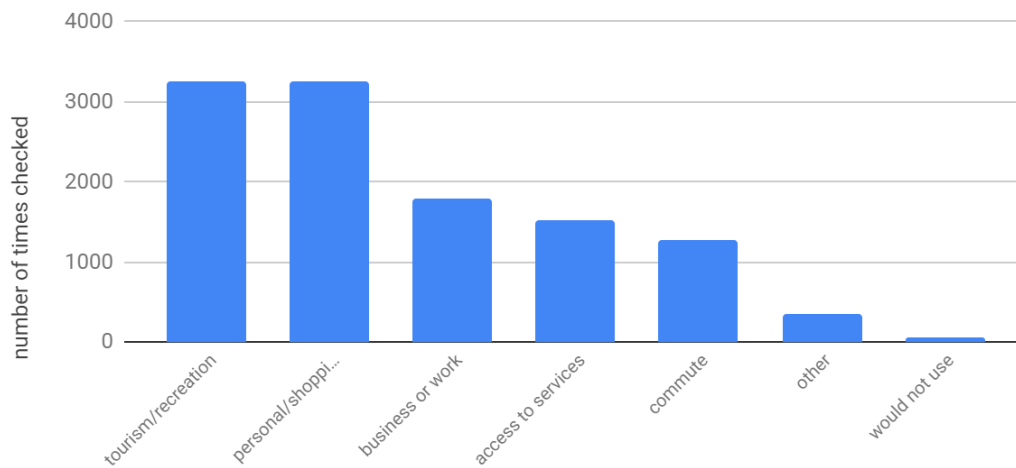

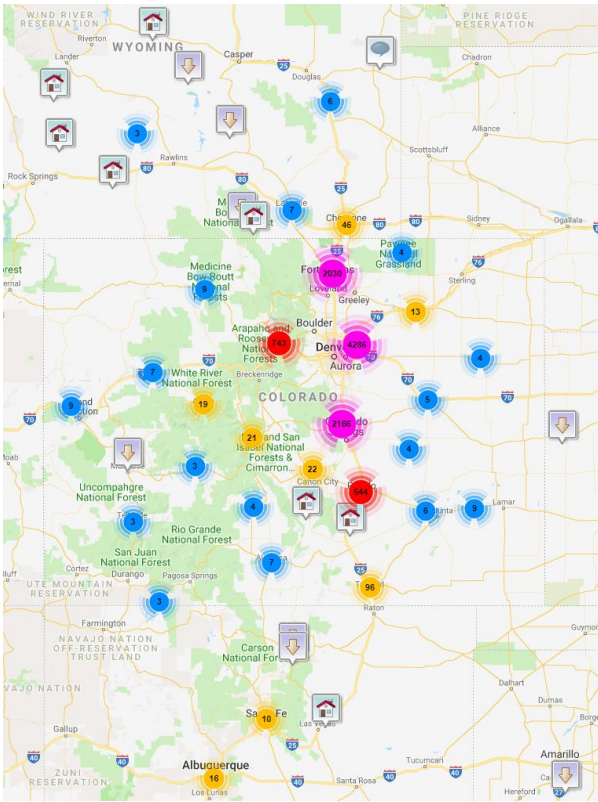

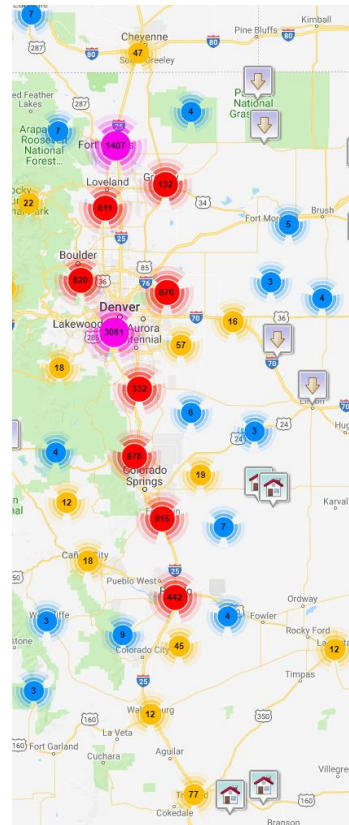

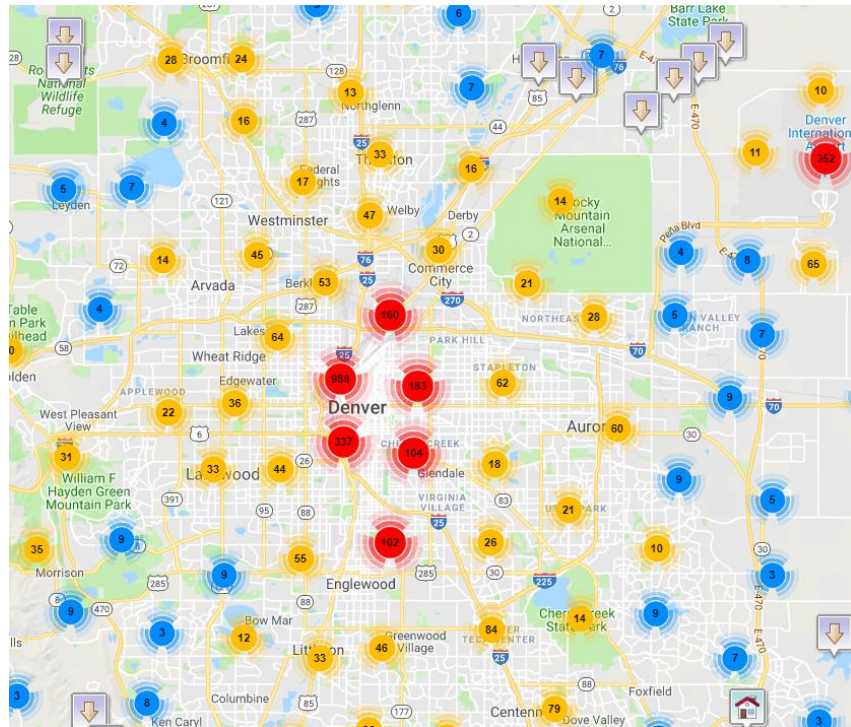

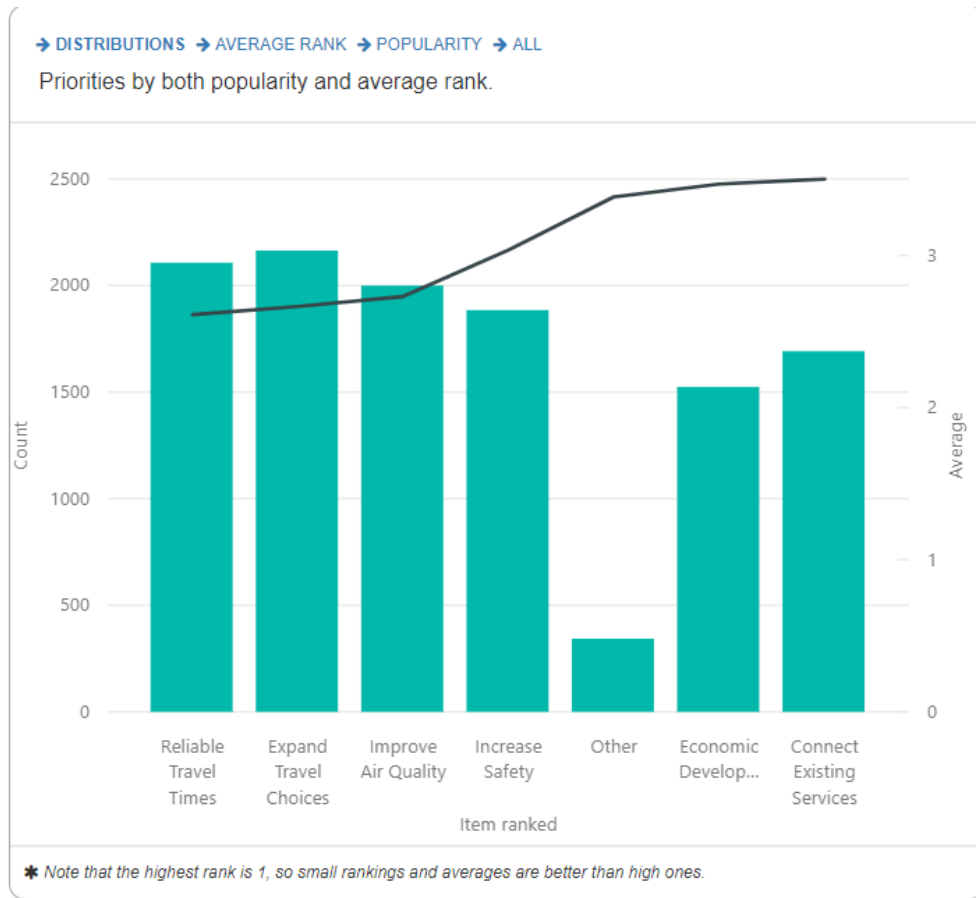


Colorado Front Range
