

Resolution # TC 17-6-16

Resolution to adopt legislative memorial designations.

Approved by the Transportation Commission on June 15, 2017.

WHEREAS, the Transportation Commission adopted Policy Directive 1503.0 to establish a consistent statewide process regarding designation or memorializing of a highway, bridge or any other highway component; and

WHEREAS, the Colorado General Assembly has the authority, by Act or Resolution, to approve designations or memorializing highways, bridges, or any other components of the highway system. And, the Transportation Commission has the authority to accept such requests from the Colorado General Assembly; and

WHEREAS, in 2017 during the First Regular Session, of the State of Colorado's Seventy First General Assembly has adopted the following Senate Joint Resolutions and House Joint Resolution; and

WHEREAS, during the 2017 Legislative Session the General Assembly adopted Senate Joint Resolution 17-008 designating the bridge that crosses south Raleigh Street in Denver on Colorado State Highway 285 as the "SSG Jordan L. Bear Bridge."; and

WHEREAS, during the 2017 Legislative Session the General Assembly adopted Senate Joint Resolution 17-017 designating the portion of Interstate 25 from mile marker 176.25 to mile marker 179.25, , as the "Trooper Donahue and Trooper Jursevics Move Over Safety Awareness Corridor"; and

WHEREAS, during the 2017 Legislative Session the General Assembly adopted House Joint Resolution HJR17-1015 designating Colorado State Highway 3 the "Captain Jeff Kuss Memorial Highway"; and


WHEREAS, during the 2017 Legislative Session the General Assembly adopted House Joint Resolution HJR17-1018 designating That the portion of State Highway 340 from the Rim Rock Drive intersection to the interchange at South Broadway, to the intersection of E 1/2 road, to the intersection of 20 1/2 road, to the intersection of South Broadway to the intersection of South Camp Road, to the intersection of Monument road the "Tour of the Moon Byway"; and

WHEREAS, during the 2017 Legislative Session the General Assembly adopted House Joint Resolution HJR17-1023 designating the portion of Highway 66 from Mile Marker 32 to Mile Marker 36 in Longmont, Colorado, the "Trooper Taylor Thyfault Memorial Highway"; and

WHEREAS, during the 2017 Legislative Session the General Assembly adopted House Joint Resolution HJR17-1029 designating Interstate Highway 76 from Mile Marker 1 to Mile Marker 183 as the "Colorado Pollinator Highway"; and

WHEREAS, during the 2017 Legislative Session the General Assembly adopted House Joint Resolution HJR17-1031 designating the Cimarron Avenue bridge spanning Interstate 25 in Colorado Springs as the "Lieutenant James "Jim" Downing Bridge";

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Transportation Commission hereby confirms Senate Joint Resolutions 17-008, 17-017, and House Joint Resolutions 17-17-1015, 17-1018, 17-1023, 17-1029, and 17-1031.
