

**Resolution # TC-17-6-3**

Repeal of Policy Directive 1401.0 "Product Evaluation and Experimental Features"

**Approved by the Transportation Commission on June 15, 2017.**

**WHEREAS**, under § 43-1-106(8), C.R.S., the Transportation Commission of Colorado has the statutory responsibility to set policies for the Colorado Department of Transportation ("CDOT"); and

**WHEREAS**, Policy Directive 1401.0 was adopted on May 21, 2009, and states that it is the policy of the Department to follow the process to equitably evaluate products and experimental features as set forth in Procedural Directive 1401.1; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department continues to comply with the process set forth in Procedural Directive 1401.1; and

**WHEREAS**, the process for product evaluation and experimental features is an issue more appropriately under the statutory responsibility of the Executive Director pursuant to § 43-1-105, C.R.S.; and

**WHEREAS**, Policy Directive 1401.0 is not needed to ensure the Department equitably evaluates products and experimental features.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, the Commission herein repeals Policy Directive 1401.0 "Product Evaluation and Experimental Features."
