

Resolution # TC-17-10-4

Approval of Updated Policy Directive 2.0 "CDOT Values"

Approved by the Transportation Commission on October 19, 2017.

WHEREAS, under § 43-1-106(8), C.R.S., the Transportation Commission of Colorado has the statutory responsibility to set policies for the Colorado Department of Transportation ("CDOT"); and

WHEREAS, Policy Directive 2.0 "CDOT Values" was last adopted on November 14, 2007; and

WHEREAS, Policy Directive 2.0 articulates the six core values of the Department, which are Safety, People, Integrity, Customer Service, Excellence, and Respect; and

WHEREAS, the six values described in updated Policy Directive 2.0 remain the same, the descriptions for some of the values have been updated to reflect current Department culture; and

WHEREAS, updated Policy Directive 2.0 now clarifies an updated articulation of the six core values of the Department.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Commission herein adopts updated Policy Directive 2.0 "CDOT Values."
