

Resolution #TC-18-05-04

FASTER Safety Mitigation Process and Procedures.

Approved by the Transportation Commission on May 17, 2018.

WHEREAS, the Transportation Commission (Commission) previously adopted resolution # TC-3161 in 2014 electing to allocate a portion of FASTER Safety funds to the FASTER Safety Mitigation Program to be maintained as a statewide pool with Regional Planning Estimates; and

WHEREAS, as defined in resolution # TC-3161, the FY 2016-2040 Program Distribution allocation methodology for this formula program for use in the Statewide Transportation Plan and Statewide Transportation Improvement (STIP) is as follows:


FASTER Safety Mitigation Program: Based on total crash data weighted according to National Safety Council values for crash type; and

WHEREAS, the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) staff determined that operating through regional pools will improve in the reporting of program level transactions and progress; and


WHEREAS, CDOT staff recommends the FASTER Safety Mitigation Program be maintained through regional pools instead of a statewide pool with Regional Planning Estimates while retaining the distribution allocation methodology as defined in # TC-3161.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Commission approves that the portion of FASTER Safety funds to the FASTER Safety Mitigation Program be maintained through regional pools.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Commission will periodically review the fund allocations that are directed by Commission decision to ensure the effectiveness of the use of funds and the Commission reserves the option to alter the allocation of those funds.
