

Resolution #TC-2022-04-10

Instructing the Colorado Department of Transportation to advance the following rural paving projects from the adopted 10-Year Plan.

Approved by the Transportation Commission on April 21, 2021

WHEREAS, the Colorado Transportation Commission has identified the following rural paving projects to advance from the fourth year of the 10-Year Plan:

- Project # 23513 - Rural Paving: US 385 North of Cheyenne Wells near Smoky Hill River to County Road GG from MP 157 to MP 170 for \$14.8 M

WHEREAS, this project has been selected and prioritized through the planning process and was included in Transportation Commission resolution #TC-19-11-7, which approved projects for Fiscal Years 2020-2022, comprising the first four years of the 10-Year Plan; and

WHEREAS, this project represents a key commitment of the 10-Year Plan to improve rural pavement condition across the state; and

WHEREAS, this project needs approval now in order to be advertised in time for the construction season; and

WHEREAS, the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) is committed to an open and transparent planning and project delivery process and therefore reviewed and discussed this project in a public workshop prior to adopting this resolution.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Colorado Transportation Commission approves advancing this rural paving project.
