

Resolution #TC-2022-12-03

Adoption of Policy Directive 20.0 “Rule Making Policy”

Approved by the Transportation Commission on December 14, 2022.

WHEREAS, pursuant to § 43-1-106(8)(k), C.R.S., the Transportation Commission of Colorado (“the Commission”) is charged with making all necessary and reasonable orders, rules, and regulations to carry out its statutory responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has established policies relative to formulating rules for consideration; and

WHEREAS, this Policy Directive has been revised to make the process for writing or adopting rules reflect modern practice, including the Commission’s choice to appoint an ad hoc committee and an explicit statement that the Commission and the Executive Director have the ability to delegate the rulemaking hearing’s administration to a Hearing Officer, but that they may never delegate adoption of a rule or regulation under their authority; and,

WHEREAS, updated Policy Directive 20.0 confirms the Commission’s commitment to a standardized and thoughtful process for rulemaking.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Commission herein adopts Policy Directive 20.0 “Rule Making Policy.”
