

Resolution #TC-2022-12-09

Resolution to Approve STIP Amendment Package 1 – Adding NEVI Funding to the *FY2023 – FY2026 STIP*

Approved by the Transportation Commission on December 14, 2022.

WHEREAS, the Colorado Transportation Commission has statutory authority pursuant to 43-1-106, C.R.S. to approve, accept, and amend various planning documents resulting from Section 135 Title 23 of the USC, and 43-1-1101 through 1105 C.R.S.; and

WHEREAS, the Commission adopted the FY2023 – FY2026 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) on May 19, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the STIP is occasionally amended due to significant changes in project scope or new funding needs to be programmed into or out of the STIP, thereby requiring an amendment to the STIP; and

WHEREAS, the funding included in this STIP Amendment #1 package incorporates funding for the National Electronic Vehicle Infrastructure (NEVI) program, the details of which can be found in the attached table; and

WHEREAS, Title 23 of the CFR, Part 450 requires a minimum 30-day public process be implemented for review and comment on proposed policy amendments, as well as Transportation Commission approval of said amendments; and

WHEREAS, the public process for the policy amendments set before the Commission was provided from November 4, 2022 through December 14, 2022, and no comments were received; and

WHEREAS, it is requested that the Transportation Commission approve this amendment, and direct staff to forward this approval to the Federal Highway Administration.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the attached STIP Amendment #1 package for December 2022 be adopted and forwarded to the Federal Highway Administration.
