

**Resolution #TC-2022-07-03**

Wadsworth/C-470 Maintenance Site Grant of Storm Drainage Easement to Douglas County

**Approved by the Transportation Commission on July 21, 2022**

**WHEREAS**, CDOT is replacing the existing outdated, undersized vehicle storage facility with a new 7-bay facility at its maintenance site located in the southeast quadrant of the Wadsworth and C-470 interchange ; and

**WHEREAS**, As a part of the project, CDOT is required to address storm water on the site as a result of the site being located in an MS4 area; and

**WEREAS**, Douglas County requires an easement for the storm drainage facilities because the lines feed into its storm water system; and

**WEREAS**, the easement will allow Douglas County to access the area for any future maintenance or repairs the storm drainage lines may require; and

**WHEREAS**, C.R.S. 24-82-202 requires approval of the Transportation Commission before CDOT can grant an easement for construction and maintenance of public utilities, or of public streets and highways, or of public services, including but not limited to sanitary sewer lines, water lines, gas lines, telephone lines, electric power lines, or other services owned and controlled by a political subdivision or public corporation of the state of Colorado or of the United States; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Transportation would like to grant the required storm drainage easement to Douglas County.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, pursuant to the provisions of the C.R.S 24-82-202 the Department of Transportation be given authority to grant an easement to Douglas County for the purposes of storm drainage improvements, and any future maintenance activities associated with the improvements.
