SUBJECT: Ninth Supplement – FY 2011

Enclosed is the approved Ninth Supplement to the FY 2011 Budget.

This supplement budgets projects for FY '11 unless otherwise noted in the explanations on the following pages. The project requests are consistent with the FY 2008 through FY 2013 STIP. Funds are available from the Regions' allocations unless otherwise indicated.

The balance of the Transportation Commission Contingency Fund is \$48,298,248.

Note:

Region 3

- \$7,000,000 – FASTER Safety – Proposal to swap funding between SH 50: Little Blue and SH 131: South of Choke Cherry - Currently in the Gunnison Valley TPR, there is approximately \$7 million of FY '11 FASTER Safety funding prioritized for the *SH 50: Little Blue West* project (total budget \$13 million). Currently in the Northwest TPR, there is \$7 million of FY '12 FASTER Safety funding prioritized for *SH 131: Choke Cherry - South*. This project could advertise late March/early April 2011, if the funds were in place, allowing the construction season to be maximized by advertising earlier in the year.

Construction advertisement is scheduled for February 2011. (17148/1000141750)

The project team has identified that replacing the switchgear in-place, which includes the replacement of the MCC units and the wiring needed to integrate them into the existing system, has the ability to provide additional benefits that include upgraded PLC units (Programmable Logic Controller) and replacement of all cables leading in and out of the MCCs (master control cabinets). This will also require PLC Training and a temporary end to end feeder option.
