Title and brief description of item
Repeal of Policy No. 504.0 Design-Build Contracting.

Describe the action requested of Commission

The Department requests that the Commission repeal Policy No. 504.0 Design-Build Contracting. The Commission adopted this Policy in 2006 to ensure uniform development of design-build contracts. Since that time, CDOT has fully implemented a Design-Build Manual. With regard to this area of CDOT, a policy is no longer necessary insofar as this area is regulated by state and federal law and CDOT rules, and the manual provides sufficient requirements and direction. This Policy's review date was May 2011. As part of CDOT's review of all existing Policies and Procedural Directives, this document has been determined to be no longer necessary.

Justification for Commission action

The Commission is authorized to formulate general policy for CDOT pursuant to 43-1-106(8)(a) C.R.S.. In this case, all processes and methods are identified and defined in the CDOT's Design-Build Manual therefore making Policy 504.0 Design-Build Contracting no longer necessary.

Repeal Policy Directive No. 504.0 “Design-Build Contracting”

WHEREAS, § 43-1-106 (8)(a) C.R.S. (2011) gives authority to the Transportation Commission of Colorado (“Commission”) to formulate the general policy with respect to the management, construction, and maintenance of public highways and other transportation systems in the state; and

WHEREAS, Policy Directive 504.0 was adopted by the Transportation Commission on May 1, 2006; and

WHEREAS, Since that time, the Project Development unit of the Department has fully implemented a Design-Build Manual which conforms to CDOT’s rules and state and federal law; and

WHEREAS, the Department’s compliance with the procedures set forth in the manual, and compliance with state and federal law is adequate to govern this area; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Commission herein REPEALS Policy Directive 504.0, “Design-Build Contracting” dated May 1, 2006.

To establish a policy that will assure the uniform development and implementation of Design-Build Contracts pursuant to the CDOT's Design-Build Manual. To establish and to provide uniform procedures and methods in Design-Build Contracting for the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) and Local Agencies.

AUTHORITY

The Colorado Transportation Commission and Executive Director.

APPLICABILITY

This Policy applies to all Regions and Staff Branches of the Colorado Department of Transportation.

POLICY

It is the policy of the Department to develop and implement Design-Build Contracts pursuant to the CDOT's Design-Build Manual. The Procedural Directive for Design-Build Contracting shall be the processes and methods identified and defined in the CDOT's Design-Build Manual.

IMPLEMENTATION

This policy is effective immediately and shall be implemented by all Divisions, Branches, Regions and Offices of CDOT.

REVIEW DATE

This Policy shall be reviewed in March 2011.
