SUBJECT: DRAFT FY2019-FY 2022 STATEWIDE TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (STIP) PUBLIC HEARING

Purpose

To provide a review of the upcoming schedule of Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) milestones for the annual adoption of the STIP, including a required 30-day public review and comment period, and public hearing.

Action Requested

No action requested.

Background

Federal regulations require that the STIP be updated at least every four years. The updated STIP is also required to be the subject of a minimum 30 day public review and comment period, and is subject to a public hearing. The Transportation Commission released the Draft FY2019 - FY2022 STIP for public review and comment at the April Commission meeting. The comment period will close on May 31, 2018. The public hearing will be held at the Transportation Commission meeting on May 17 in Durango, Colorado. Staff intends to return to the Commission in June and request adoption of the STIP. Typically, the public review and comment period and public hearing are held a month earlier, with adoption in May. However, the recent cyber incident impacted the ability to enter STIP data, necessitating a one month delay.
