**SUBJECT:** Adoption of the *FY2021 - FY2024 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program* (STIP)

**Purpose**

This memo summarizes the status of the *FY2021 - FY2024 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program* (STIP) to inform the Transportation Commission (TC) in preparation for the adoption request.

**Action**

Staff requests Transportation Commission adoption of the *FY2021 - FY2024 STIP*.

**Background**

The *FY2021 - FY2024 STIP* is available at: <https://www.codot.gov/business/budget>.

The *FY2020 - FY2023 STIP* will replace the current *FY2020 - FY2023 STIP*. This updated STIP will incorporate the recently adopted *FY2021 - FY2024 TIP* for the Pikes Peak Area COG.

At the regular meeting on June 18, staff intends to present the Transportation Commission with the final *FY2021 - FY2024 STIP*. At that time, staff will summarize all changes made since the release of the *Draft FY2021 - FY2024 STIP*, review public comments received, and present CDOT's responses to public comments received. Staff will then be requesting the Transportation Commission adopt the STIP based on the following:

- The STIP has been developed in accordance with 23 CFR Parts 450.210 and 450.216.
- It has been reviewed by staff to ensure that it meets fiscal constraint.
- It is anticipated that the updated MPO TIP for Pikes Peak Area Council of Governments (PPACG) will be signed and approved by the Governor by June 30, 2020. The updated TIPs will be adopted into the STIP administratively at that time.
- A public involvement process was provided for comments from May 6 through June 5, 2020. An electronic copy of the draft was also posted on CDOT's external website. Comments received thus far have been either grammatical or technical in nature. A response has been sent to each commenter and there are no outstanding issues to be resolved.
- A public hearing with the Transportation Commission took place during its regular meeting on May 21, 2020. No comments were received during this hearing.

Also included as an attachment, for your approval, is the draft resolution for Transportation Commission adoption of the *FY2021 - FY2024 STIP*. Once adopted, the *FY2021 - FY2024 STIP* will be forwarded on to the Colorado Division office for the Federal Highway Administration and the Region 8 office of the Federal Transit Administration for their final approval. The *FY2021 - FY2024 STIP* will become effective July 1, 2020.
