Project Description

CDOT is proposing upgrades and maintenance at The Eisenhower Johnson Memorial Tunnels (EJMT), including addressing issues associated with freezing of existing water lines, seep lines and fire hydrant connections, replacing the emergency generators, rewinding the fan motors, and making upgrades to the water treatment plant and piping system. Because the project does not contain federal funding, or an FHWA nexus, Section 4(f) requirements apply. However, Section 6(f) requirements always apply.

The project area was reviewed for recreation and Section 6(f) resources using GIS, Google Maps, and local agency planning documents (see Map 1). Loveland Ski Area is located to the south of I-70 and the Tunnels, with an access road and parking area just east of the tunnels. Loveland Ski Area is a privately-owned facility. No Section 6(f) resources were identified in the area. Impacts to recreational properties are not anticipated because the work is proposed to occur within the immediate area of the tunnels and entirely within right-of-way.
