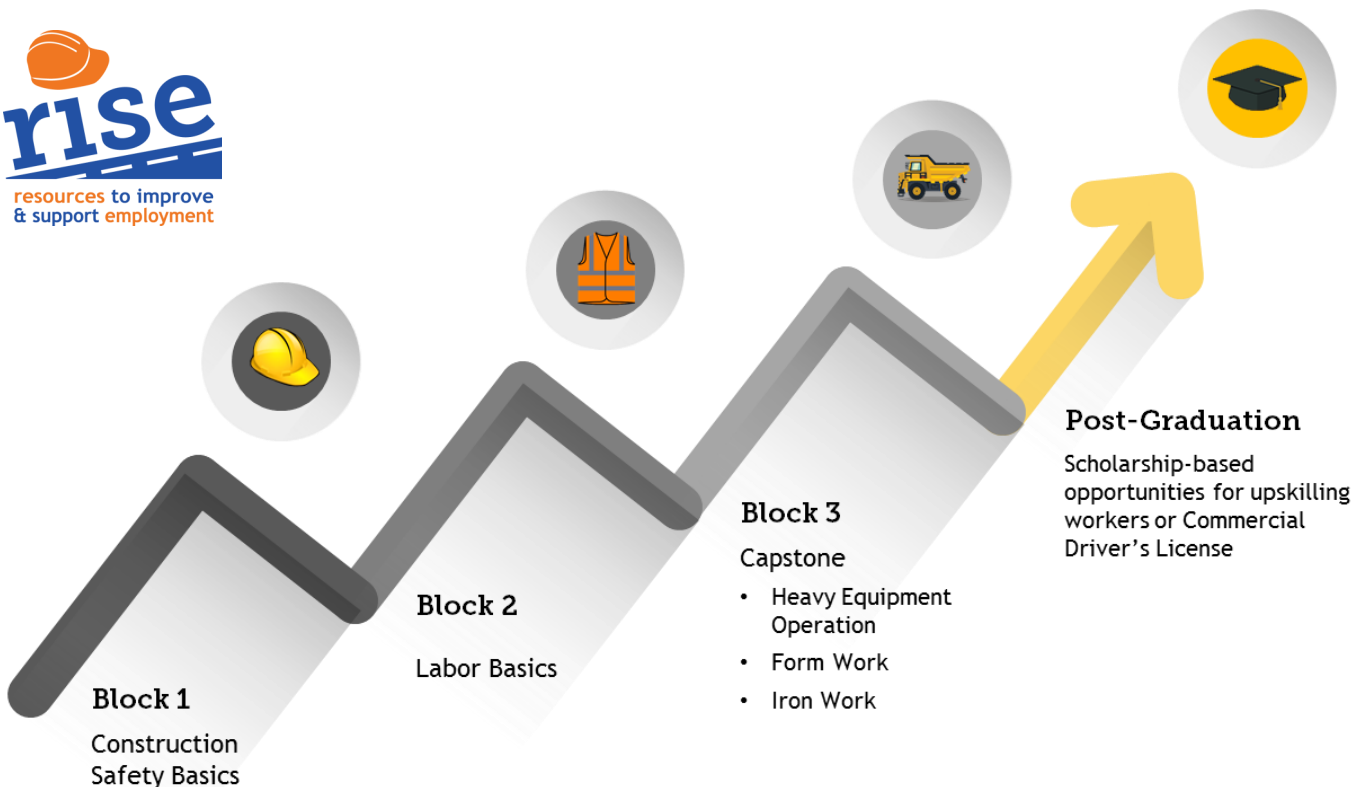

RISE Curriculum Overview

RISE partners with institutions statewide to provide education and certification opportunities for individuals looking to work in the construction industry and for those wanting to increase their current abilities. Its comprehensive curriculum gives students both classroom and field experience in a variety of construction work, including OSHA 10, Flagging, Heavy Equipment Operation, Form Work, and more.



Services for Trainees

RISE provides support for individuals entering a career in construction or seeking to increase their skills through services such as:

- Free personal protective equipment
- Training scholarships
- Access to wraparound services like childcare vouchers and bus passes
