Overview

The review panel for evaluation of Non-Standard (NSM) Asphalt Mixture submittals convened on April 14, 2011, in accordance with the Colorado Procedure 59 (CP-59). Rocky Mountain Materials and Asphalt's submittal for using Evotherm 3G (J1 and M1) was reviewed.

Quality of Submittal

While Rocky Mountain Materials and Asphalt's submittal showed no experience with Evotherm, the submittal was very detailed and comprehensive with regards to design considerations and production considerations.

NSM Decision

Rocky Mountain Materials and Asphalt is approved by the panel to use Evotherm 3G (J1 and M1) WMA technology. This contractor will be listed as approved to use this technology on the CDOT website under the category of Approved NSM Contractors.
