Summary Observations

An on-site ADA survey was conducted September 27, 2016, by Patrick Going, ADA Consultant. All observations are based on the *2010 ADA Standards for Accessible Design*. These Standards may be found at <u>www.access-board.gov</u>.

Bair Ranch is available for both east bound and west bound travelers. It is on the east end of the popular Glenwood Canyon bike path.

It is accessible to people with disabilities and is well maintained.

Parking

The auto parking area has 21 spaces including two (2) accessible spaces, one of which is 'van.' Trucks and RVs have 5 spaces.

Path-of-Travel

The route from the accessible parking spaces to the restroom building is good.

Rest Rooms

The men's and women's restrooms are ADA compliant and have a full-size accessible toilet stall. The sink pipes should be wrapped.

Visitor Information, Vending Machines, Picnic Tables


The information displays and vending machines are accessible. Suggest replacing one of the picnic tables with an accessible table which allows a person using a wheelchair to use the table top.
