## Summary Observations

An on-site ADA survey was conducted September 28, 2016, by Patrick Going, ADA Consultant. All observations are based on the *2010 ADA Standards for Accessible Design*. These Standards may be found at [www.access-board.gov](http://www.access-board.gov).

This is a modern, well-maintained rest area with easy access off I-70. This rest area is very accessible for people with disabilities though a few minor adjustments are needed; e.g. add 'van' parking sign to one post, wrap sink pipes, add restroom signs on wall.

## Parking

There are 48 parking spaces with three (3) designated accessible parking spaces. There is a requirement that 1:6, but no less than one, of the accessible spaces be a 'van' space (§208.2.4). The two accessible parking spaces on northeast side need one access aisle, 8' wide, between them. Add 'van' sign to one post.

There is a separate parking area for RV's and trucks. A curb cut is needed in sidewalk for access to the building.

## Path-of-Travel

The route from the current accessible parking spaces to the building are ADA compliant.

## Rest Rooms

In general, the men's, women's, and family restrooms are ADA compliant with the exception the sink pipes need wrapping and signs need to be added to the wall - adjacent to the latch side of doors.

## Vending Machines and Visitor Information

There is ample circulation space to reach the vending machines and visitor information.

## Dog Relief Areas

There are numerous designated 'dog relief' areas. Most are accessible for people with assistive mobility devices.
