Hands on course to provide an intro to concrete application and materials--hands-on ; Requires either Construction / Labor Basics, or equivalent course, AND have at least 6 months of experience

CDL B License

Dates vary; options 7 days per week

Practice course to gain CDL B license; requires DOT physical card and current permit to start
