

INVITATION FOR CONSULTANT SERVICES
For Non-Project Specific Environmental Science and Engineering Investigation and
Remediation Services

Public Notice for Professional Consultants

The selected consultants will contract with CDOT to provide non-project specific environmental science and engineering investigation and remediation services to CDOT on a statewide basis. The contract work will be done on an "as needed basis". The term "as needed" means neither CDOT nor the consultant has an obligation under the contract unless and until a task order is issued. Contracts resulting from the Invitation for Consultant Services are considered a "pricing agreement". The term of the contract shall be for two years, with an option, at CDOT's sole discretion, to extend any one or all of the contracts for up to one (1) additional one-year term. The contract amount shall not exceed \$400,000.00. CDOT intends to select Two (2) consultants. CDOT may elect to use this contract for projects in other CDOT regions with consultant and Region HQ approval.

DESCRIPTION: The environmental science and engineering investigation and remediation services to be provided by the Consultant will consist of all work necessary to accomplish the assigned tasks in any of the following categories of effort: A) Hazardous Waste Remediation; B) Petroleum Waste Remediation; C) Solid Waste Remediation; D) Site Investigation/Characterization; E) Spill Response; F) Second Opinion Services; G) Expert Witness Services; H) Site Restoration Services; and I) Technical Advisory Assistance.

SPECIAL PROJECT REQUIREMENT: All work is to be performed under the direction and supervision, appropriate to the task, of a Colorado-Licensed Professional Engineer, a Colorado-Licensed Professional Land Surveyor for Surveying services, a Landscape Architect, a Certified Industrial Hygienist, or, as appropriate, any combination of the foregoing.

- The prime firm of each team must be on CDOT's list of prequalified consultants by September 18, 2008 . **Prequalification must be done annually. The prime firm and/or members of its team must be able to demonstrate capacity in the following disciplines: EN-Environmental Engineering, GE-Geotechnical Engineering, Hydrogeology, MC-Engineering Management (Construction), MT-Materials Testing, SE-Structural Engineering, SU-Surveying, and TR-Traffic Engineering.** Consultants who are not prequalified or who have questions regarding their prequalification, should immediately contact Mike Dapceovich, Agreements Office at telephone (303) 757-9618.

CDOT will be holding interviews for this consultant selection. From those firms submitting a Statement of Interest/Work Plan (SOI/WP), CDOT will short-list no less than three firms for interviews, using the following criteria for final selection: Workload Factor; Project Team; Firm Capability; Past Performance on Similar Projects/Similar Teams; Work Location; Capacity; UDBE Participation; ESB Participation; Project Goals, Project Control, Project Concept, and Project Critical Issues.

Those firms that make the Short-List will be scheduled for the Presentation/Interview process, approximately 2-3 weeks from short-list notification.

The Department has determined the contract goal for UDBE participation in this contract will be met with certified DBEs who have been determined to be underutilized on professional services contracts.
