DESCRIPTION: CDOT intends on hiring TWO (2) consultants for the contract described below. **The services to be provided by the Consultant will consist of all work necessary to accomplish the assigned tasks in any of the following categories of effort:** The work may include all or parts of the following as defined by the Scope of Work and the task order description; Bridge Design Activities, Bridge Detailing Activities, Independent Bridge Design Check Activities, Existing Bridge Rating Activities and Bridge Special Studies.

**SPECIAL PROJECT REQUIREMENT:** All work is to be performed under the direction and supervision, appropriate to the task, of a Colorado-Licensed Professional Engineer.
