

INVITATION FOR CONSULTANT SERVICES
Public Notice for Professional Consultants
For Non-Project Specific Environmental Science and Engineering Services
Colorado Department of Transportation
Location: Statewide

CDOT intends to select Three (3) consultant firms for the provisioning of Statewide NPS Environmental Services for a 2 year period with a 1 year option.

The selected consultants will contract with CDOT to provide non-project specific environmental science and engineering services to CDOT on a statewide basis. The contract work will be done on an "as needed basis". The term "as needed" means neither CDOT nor the consultant has an obligation under the contract unless and until a task order is issued. Contracts resulting from the Invitation for Consultant Services are considered a "pricing agreement". The term of the contract shall be for two years, with an option, at CDOT's sole discretion, to extend any one or all of the contracts for up to one (1) additional one-year term.

The contract amounts shall not exceed \$1,500,000.00

DESCRIPTION: The environmental science and engineering services to be provided by the Consultant will consist of all work necessary to accomplish the assigned tasks in any of the following categories of effort:

- A. Professional Engineering Hydraulic Landscape Architect Services**
- B. Transportation Planning Services**
- C. Environmental Services**
- D. General Administrative Requirements**

SPECIAL PROJECT REQUIREMENT: All work is to be performed under the direction and supervision, appropriate to the task, of a Colorado-Licensed Professional Engineer, a Colorado-Licensed Professional Land Surveyor for Surveying services, a Landscape Architect, a Certified Industrial Hygienist, or, as appropriate, any combination of the foregoing.

- **The prime firm of each team must be on CDOT's list of prequalified consultants by January 13, 2011. Prequalification must be done annually. The prime firm and/or members of its team must be able to demonstrate capacity in the following disciplines: EN-Environmental Engineering, GE-Geotechnical Engineering, HY-Hydraulics, MT-Materials Testing, SE-Structural Engineering, SU-Surveying, MC – Management Construction and TR-Traffic Engineering.** Consultants who are not prequalified, or who have questions regarding their prequalification should immediately contact Mike Dapceвич, Agreements Office at telephone (303) 757-9618.

From those firms submitting a Statement of Interest/Work Plan (SOI/WP), CDOT will short-list no less than three firms for final contract award using the following criteria for final selection: Workload Factor; Project Team; Firm Capability; Past Performance on Similar Projects/Similar Teams; Work Location; Capacity; UDBE Participation; ESB Participation; Project Goals, Project Control, Project Concept, and Project Critical Issues.

UDBE GOAL

The Department has determined the contract goal for UDBE participation in this contract will be met with certified DBEs who have been determined to be underutilized on professional services contracts. At this time, **all DBEs** will be considered to be UDBEs. The UDBE goal for this project is Ten Percent (**10 %**)

The type of compensation for these contracts will be Cost Plus Fixed Fee.
