

**Q&A Related to RFP for  
Co-Development, Multi-Modal, I-70 Mountain Corridor Project**

1. Do you wish to keep résumés to one page per person?  
**ANSWER: Each résumé can be up to two pages in length.**
  
2. May we double-side résumés in the Appendix to conserve space?  
**ANSWER: Yes.**
  
3. Does Exhibit C - Risk Matrix that we are required to fill out count against the page limit? The instructions say that “exhibits and forms” do not count.  
**ANSWER: The Risk Matrix will not count against the page limit as long as it’s included as an exhibit after Part 1 of the Proposal. If you choose to include the Risk Matrix in Part 1, it would count towards the page limit.**
  
4. How will the Risk Register be scored?  
**ANSWER: The Risk Register will be considered/scored in the “Project and Risk Management Approach” shown in Table 2 – Scoring Allocations for Part 1 (see section 7.1 of the RFP). The Risk Register is not related to the Cost and Risk Sharing approach that is to be included in Part 2.**
  
5. Please clarify the number of pages allowed in the Appendix. It appears that 15 pages are allowed for extra content and that forms/exhibits including the Form A Resumes that are required, need to be in an appendix but will not count toward the 15 pages.  
**ANSWER: To help clarify, here’s a breakdown of allowable page limits:**
  - **50 single-sided pages for the Part 1 Technical Proposal**
  - **15 single-sided pages for a Technical Appendix to support the Part 1 Technical Proposal**
  - **15 single-sided pages for Part 2 Cost/Risk Sharing Proposal**
  - **The cover letter, forms, addenda, section dividers and required appendices/exhibits will not count against any of the page limits listed above.**
  
6. In the graphics, are we allowed to use a font other than Times New Roman?  
**ANSWER: Yes**
  
7. Can we re-format Form A to look a little more like the rest of our proposal?  
**ANSWER: Yes, as long as you clearly label “Form A” at the top.**
