Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) Region 1 intends to hire one (1) Professional Consultant for this Project. The selected Consultant will contract with CDOT to provide Project Specific Construction Management Inspection & Materials Testing Engineering Services for Wadsworth Highlands to 10<sup>th</sup> Project to include those specific services set forth below and in the Scope of Work (SOW)

CDOT intends to hire One (1) consultant firm for this project.

**Project Description** *Wadsworth, Highland to 10<sup>th</sup>*

Project # STU 1211-084 (19868) is to add an additional lane onto Wadsworth Blvd. from Highland Street (approximately 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue) to 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue in the County of Jefferson and City of Lakewood. The proposed lanes are 12 feet wide. The ultimate goal for the project is to improve safety, reduce access deficiencies, and improve traffic flow on Wadsworth Blvd.

**Construction Management Services**

The requested personnel staffing required for the construction management services for the project include: one *(1) Assistant Project Engineer and three (3) Inspectors* to be utilized on the project. The consultant will also supply scheduling analysis and evaluation

**Project Duration**

Full time services are anticipated from approximately November 2014 through December 2015 (includes the duration of the construction, potential adjustments to construction contract time, plus pre and post construction activities as required). Work may be required at night and/or day, on weekends, holidays, and/or on a split-shift basis. Work weeks may be in excess of or less than the standard 40-hour week.

**SPECIAL PROJECT REQUIREMENT:** All work is to be performed under the direction and supervision, appropriate to the task, of a Colorado-Licensed Professional Engineer, a Colorado-Licensed Professional Land Surveyor for Surveying Services, a Certified Industrial Hygienist or as appropriate, any combination of the foregoing.

**Interested Consultants:**

The prime firm of each team must be on CDOT's list of prequalified consultants by August 21, 2014. Prequalification must be done annually.
