CONTRACT REQUIREMENT FOR INTERESTED CONSULTANTS

Per the Chief Engineer policy memorandum, all consultant firms competing as "Prime" Consultant, for this Advertisement and Solicitation, must have an "Audited Indirect Cost (overhead) Rate" that complies with Federal Acquisition Regulations (FAR) and AASHTO Audit Guide in order to compete and be eligible for contract award. Interested firms that do not have a current audited indirect cost rate, and bill on a "Fee Schedule" may request a waiver of this policy from the CDOT Chief Engineer, who will consider factors relevant to the audited rate.
