CONTRACT REQUIREMENT FOR INTERESTED CONSULTANTS

Per the Chief Engineer policy memorandum, effective July 1, 2014 all consultant firms competing as “Prime” Consultant, for this Advertisement and Solicitation, must have an “*Audited Indirect Cost (overhead) Rate*” that complies with Federal Acquisition Regulations (FAR) and AASHTO Audit Guide in order to compete and be eligible for contract award. Interested firms that do not have a current audited indirect cost rate, and bill on a “Fee Schedule” may request a waiver of this policy from the CDOT Chief Engineer, who will consider factors relevant to the audited rate.

Waivers are granted at the Chief Engineer’s sole discretion.
