Statewide Construction Management/Inspection/Testing Program**

Public Notice for Professional Consultants

DESCRIPTION:

The Colorado Department of Transportation has identified 59 Construction Management, Construction Inspection, And Materials Testing projects necessary to meet the anticipated program Construction Management needs for all five regions in the calendar year 2016. These projects have been packaged together by program for a total of eleven (11) packages. These packages have then been organized into two geographic regions – (1) the Western Slope, which includes the packages for Regions 3 and 5 and (2) the Front Range, which includes the packages for Regions 1, 2, and 4. Consultants may submit statements of interest for one or both geographic areas, in accordance with the attached SOI Instructions. Consultants who submit SOIs may be awarded any package within the area(s) that they have identified in their SOI. A summary of the projects, packages, their known staffing needs, and approximate sizes by dollar value can be found in Exhibit A.

CDOT will be hiring a minimum of three (3) Consultant's for this project to provide **Construction Management/Inspection/Testing Program**. Please see the CDOT Website or Vendor Portal for a copy of the Scope of Work. **Please note that this solicitation is for two locations (Western Slope/Front Range), each location requires a separate section in the Statement of Interest. Consultants are able to bid on one or both locations.**

CDOT will not hold interviews for this consultant selection. From those firms submitting a Statement of Interest/Work Plan (SOI/WP), CDOT will make the final selection from the highest scoring firm for each geographic location package, provided that no less than three firms may be selected between all program contracts identified in this solicitation. Please **submit electronically through the CDOT Portal, or submit eight (8) copies** of your SOI/WP to accommodate the members of the board. Please refer to the SOI/WP Instructions to ensure compliance with the page and exhibit limits for the SOI/WP sections of your submittal. Submit all copies of Statement of Interest/Work Plan by the due date and time as stated in the "Invitation for Consultant Services."

SPECIAL PROJECT REQUIREMENT: All work is to be performed under the direction and supervision, appropriate to the task, of a Colorado-Licensed Professional Engineer.

PLEASE NOTE: ALL PARTIES SUBMITTING A PROPOSAL, IN ADDITION TO ALL SUBCONSULTANTS ON THE PROPOSED TEAM, MUST BE PREQUALIFIED AND HAVE A MPA WITH CDOT PRIOR TO AWARD OF CONTRACT

- The prime firm of each team must be on CDOT's list of prequalified consultants by **1/7/16**. Prequalification must be done annually. **The prime firm must be prequalified in the following disciplines: Construction Management (CM), Construction Inspection (CI), Materials Testing (MT)**

20% *Approach*

The DBE Goal for region 4 is 13%
