CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT, INSPECTION & MATERIALS TESTING**

The Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) intends to hire one (1) Professional Consultant Firm to provide Project Specific Construction Management for the SH 340 Redlands Parkway.

CDOT requirements are for one (1) full time Assistant Project Manager (APM), one (1) full time Inspector and one (1) full time Materials Tester for the referenced project. The project APM and Inspectors will be responsible for day to day inspection and documentation activities as assigned by the CDOT Project Manager. The Materials Tester will be responsible for materials sampling, testing and documentation as directed by the Project Manager. All consultant staff must also be available for night work as required by the Contractor's schedule.

Description of Project

Construction Management Services requested are to be provided on CDOT Project SHE 340A-018 (20145) and includes roundabout (RAB) intersection improvements, resurfacing, curb and gutter, drainage items, lighting, signing, ADA and pedestrian facilities.

Project Location

The Project Limits are on SH 340 from MP 8.5 to 10.5 in Grand Junction, CO

Work Duration

Consultant staff should be available October 2017 through December 2018

Project Team; Firm Capability; Past Performance on Similar Projects/Similar Teams; Project Goals, Project Control, Project Concept, Project Critical Issues; and UDBE & ESB Participation

NOTE: Firms submitting a Statement of Interest/Work Plan (SOI/WP) must, in their submitted SOI/WP, expressly commit, and identify by name, key employees of their own staff, as well as of the staffs of the sub-consultants on their teams, to be available to do the Work.

The Department has determined the contract goal for UDBE participation in this contract will be met with certified DBEs who have been determined to be underutilized on professional services contracts.

At this time all DBEs will be considered to be UDBEs

UDBE GOAL: 15%

To be eligible for contract award, the prime consultant must have an Audited Indirect Cost Rate that is compliant with Federal Acquisition Requirements. (FAR Compliant)
