Retirement of CDOT Project Information Signs G20-10 and G20-11

Purpose

The purpose of this Design Bulletin is to notify Designers and Project Engineers of the retirement of project information signs (G20-10 and G20-11) in compliance with the 11th Edition of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD). These changes ensure CDOT standards align with federal safety requirements regarding sign content.

Necessary Actions

1. Discontinue Use of Retired Signs:

- The 11th Edition MUTCD prohibited the use of telephone numbers on signs.
- Because of this prohibition, the CDOT Project Information signs G20-10 and G20-11 are officially retired and have been removed from the S-630-1 Standard (Traffic Controls for Highway Construction) as of January 14, 2026.

2. Implementation Timeline:

- **Existing Projects:** Projects currently under construction or advertised before January 18, 2026 (the effective date of the 11th Edition MUTCD) may continue to use the G20-10 and G20-11 signs.
- **New Projects:** For all projects advertised after January 18, 2026, and all projects currently under design, the G20-10 and G20-11 signs shall not be used.

3. Alternative Signage (MUTCD I2-5):

- The MUTCD I2-5 Project Information Sign may be used as a replacement ([refer MUTCD Section 2H.09](#)). This sign shall only be included in the plans if explicitly specified in the project specific Special Provision 626 - Public Information Services.
