InRoads Template Layer Naming Convention

Did you know that when creating your surfaces from your Typical section templates you should consider placing a layer designation that uniquely identifies the roadway you are working on? For example, use something like "S.H. 13 Subgrade" and "24 Rd Subgrade" to identify the subgrade layers instead of just "Subgrade". This way if you have to merge both subgrade layers later on, you can do this without having to save one surface as another. A little data naming organization early on will save headaches later.
