4. Describe your experience with construction contract administration:

Have prepared construction contracts in Colorado which have referenced DCOT specifications, along with supporting City or County specifications if relevant. Have also worked on Corps of Engineer projects in the design phase. Have managed construction projects with CDOT contract documents, Hawaii DOT contract documents, and Arkansas DOT contract documents. Have prepared and managed contract change order documents in Colorado, Hawaii, and Arkansas

Managed Subdivision Project in Yolo County, CA with CALTRANS contract documents, SHWPP requirements, infrastructure, a water treatment and wastewater treatment facility.

5. Describe your construction field experience:

As college student, worked as laborer on box bridge project and was a surveyor for CALTRANS. Project Construction Manager for Hawaii Animal Quarantine Station relocation and for 1000-foot viaduct on H-3 (2 projects). Project Construction Manager for Haleiwa Bypass Project of 2 1/2 mile roadway and 5 bridge projects (lengths from 190 feet to 1400 feet). Program Manager for Colorado Springs SCIP program; completed 10 projects, including 2 widenings of Academy Boulevard, extension of Rusina Road, intersection improvements, and drainage structures. Program manager for Colorado Springs '96 Tax Refund Program of 15 projects, including Sand Creek bridge for Palmer Park Street. Program manager for PPRTA roadway maintenance for Colorado Springs Maintenance Div. for 3 years, including milling and overlay, slurry seal and chip seal work. Managed subdivision and business park infrastructure.

6. Describe your DRB (or arbitration) training, certification, and experience:

While at Fletcher-Pacific in Hawaii, worked closely with Jack Craig, Engineering Claims/Dispute Manager, from the New Zealand home office (Fletcher Construction Company Limited) on Haleiwa Bypass Claim, which had a Standing Dispute Review Board as part of the project. The project was \$32 million and our claim was for an additional \$14 million. We won the claim. See Section 2 above. Testified as a witness in a trial regarding subcontractor claim on lost profit, as noted in Section 2 above.

Served as Expert Witness in Guam on a claim regarding concrete curb, gutter and sidewalk work.

Attended seminar on Colorado Construction Law.

7. Describe your employment/retirement status and availability to serve on a DRB and geographical area:

I retired in February, 2008 and am available for DRB work anywhere in Colorado.

I am very methodical and can readily analyze matters that can make up a dispute. I've done research to support or deny a claim. Having worked for both consultants and contractors in my 50-year career, I have good insight into both sides of a dispute. Have worked in consultant offices, client offices and field offices for contractors on Public works, subdivision and commercial infrastructures, and heavy civil projects.

I have the time and the experience to serve on a Disputes Review Board here in Colorado, and welcome that opportunity.
