SUBJECT: Revision of Section 208, Erosion Control

Effective this date, our unit is issuing a revised version of standard special provision, Revision of Section 208, Erosion Control. This revised standard special provision is 23 pages long and replaces a standard special provision having the same title dated March 29, 2016.

Use this revised standard special provision in projects having erosion control, beginning with projects advertised on or after October 20, 2016. You are free to use this standard special provision in projects advertised before this date.

This revisions contained in this version remove the wall thickness requirements for metal T-posts, correcting the gauge for silt fence geotextile to 14 gauge. In addition, they correct the typographical error found in the definitions of Areas of Disturbance (AD) and Limits of Disturbance (LDA).

Those of you who keep a book of Standard Special Provisions should replace the now obsolete standard special provision with this revised version. For your convenience, you can find this and others special provisions issued this date in one place at our Construction Specifications web page:
