SUBJECT: The Minimum Wages on Federal Aid Projects

Attached is a copy of the Minimum Wages, Colorado, U.S. Department of Labor General Decision Nos. **CO20100014** and **CO20100015 MOD 6**, Highway Construction, Statewide, 9 pages, dated **July 15, 2011**. It is to be included in all federal aid projects beginning with projects that have bid openings on **July 25, 2011** or later. Use this standard special provision on all federal-aid projects with contracts exceeding \$2000, except for non-ARRA projects on roadways classified as local roads or rural minor collectors, which are exempt. Projects on local roads, rural minor collectors, and enhancement projects funded with ARRA funds are not exempt.

MOD 6 changed the fringe benefits for Electricians in Adams, Arapahoe, Boulder, Broomfield, Denver, Douglas, Jefferson, Larimer, Weld, Clear Creek, Eagle, Gilpin, Grand, Jackson, Lake, Logan, Morgan, Phillips, Sedgwick, Summit, Washington, and Yuma counties.
