 Reason for this new or changed specification: CDOT will now be requiring payrolls be submitted by Contractors and subcontractors using LCP Tracker, a web based software application. The transition to the use of the new software will include the following steps: Pilot projects – pilot projects being advertised this year will include a project special provision, the Revision of Section 107 Project Payrolls. This special provision will incorporate language from the standard special provision Revision of Section 107, Project Payrolls, along with language describing the need for the software and identifying the link to it. This will be divided into two stages, projects with Contract amounts of 2 million dollars or less, followed by projects with Contract amounts of 5 million dollars or less, followed by projects with Contract amounts of 5 million dollars or less, the first page of the Standard Special Provision, Required Contract Provisions, Federal-Aid Construction Contracts will be revised to include the language from the above mentioned project special provision.
