Subject: The Davis-Bacon Minimum Wages on Federal-Aid Projects

SSU is issuing the new Minimum Wages, Colorado, U.S. Department of Labor, General Decision Number **CO20260006, Mod 1**, standard special provision, **effective May 18, 2026**. This revised standard special is 10 pages. It is to be included in all federal-aid projects, beginning with those that have bid openings on or after **5/18/2026**.

Use this standard special provision on all federal-aid projects with contracts exceeding \$2,000, except for non-ARRA projects on roadways classified as local roads or rural minor collectors, which are exempt. Projects on local roads, rural minor collectors, and enhancement projects funded with ARRA funds are not exempt.

This new decision changed as follows:

Electrician (Traffic Signalization Only)

Under the ELEC0111-003 classification for **Clear Creek County**, the base hourly rate remained the same, but the **fringe benefits decreased**:

Version / Modification	Base Rate	Fringe Benefits
Previous (Mod 0 - 01/09/2026)	\$38.97	13.75% + \$7.80
Current (Mod 1 - 05/18/2026)	\$38.97	\$13.16
