## 4. Describe your experience with construction contract administration:

While at Bechtel, served as Manager of Contracts for several projects where the firm was the CM contractor, including a \$400 million project in Western Australia which included roads, railroads and mine development, a road building project in Saudia Arabia, and airports in Jordan and Saudi Arabia. At the Mashantucket Pequot Tribe, was in charge of the planning, design and construction of a number of projects including residential and commercial buildings, utility systems, road systems and a golf course. These aggregated to several hundred million dollars in value.

At Bechtel, the aforementioned project in Australia was a field position. Prior to that at Bechtel I was resident field engingeer for the construction of a very large space environment simultion chamber at the NASA Manned Spacecraft Center, Houston, TX. While on active duty with the United States Navy, I was Ship Superintendent for construction of missle launcing nuclear submarines at Mare Island Naval Shipyard.

## 6. Describe your DRB (or arbitration) training, certification, and experience:

Have taken numerous courses in the area of construction arbitration and dispute review boards, and am certified by the AAA in the former, and the DRBF in the latter. I have served on about fifteen arbitration panels, includin several involving disputes in the \$20 to \$50 million range, and one bridge construction project for the Colorado DOT (1988). I was a DRB member for a \$500 million power plant construction in Great Britain.
