### **Modified Phase I ESA Addendum**

April 7, 2009

This letter is designed to provide an update to the *Phase I Environmental Site Assessment – US 36 Corridor* (Pinyon Environmental Engineering Resources, Inc. October 2004) that was completed for the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) in July 2007. This 2009 Addendum involved an update and review of the federal, state, and local regulatory databases for current and historic known releases or uses of hazardous substances and/or petroleum products. Historic land uses identified in the 2004 Phase I and ranked as having a potential moderate or high impact were included in the updated Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS) Site Ranking tables for Packages 2 and 4, and the Combined Alternative Package. Sites within 0.5 mile of the corridor were classified following the DEIS methodology, with a minor deviation. For the 2009 Addendum, all Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) generators (Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity, Small, and Large) and registered tanks that had no documented releases or violations were ranked as having a low potential to impact the project. This ranking methodology differed from the 2004 Phase I methodology, which included all registered generators and tanks within 2,000 feet of the project. As a result, the number of moderate or high potential impact sites considerably decreased between the 2004 and 2009 evaluations. All sites identified in the database search and located within 0.1 mile of the CAP project footprint were evaluated for potential risks to the project. Many were ranked as low, due to their minimal potential to impact the project. A low potential for impact to the project still exists from generators and other low ranking sites, so all acquisition sites would need to be re-evaluated after final plans are developed. Liability associated with acquisitions was not used as a risk identifying criterion.

### **Description of the Combined Alternative Package (Preferred Alternative) Project Work:**

Through public comments and agency and community support, a new hybrid alternative package was developed that contained aspects of both build Packages 2 and 4. The new and preferred build option is referred to as the Combined Alternative Package (Preferred Alternative). The Preferred Alternative would add one managed lane in each direction on United States Highway 36 (US 36) and auxiliary lanes between most interchanges. In addition, the Preferred Alternative would improve cross street intersections and interchanges, including lane transitions of ramp terminals, widening cross streets at intersections, lengthening turn-lanes, and adding turn-lanes.

## Conclusion


Because of the time that has passed since the DEIS was completed, the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) reviewed the hazardous material sites within 0.5 mile of the new Preferred Alternative project footprint. Identified sites were then ranked low, moderate, or high based on such factors as proximity to the corridor, known or suspected contamination, and potential for contamination to migrate. Sites identified that have a moderate or high potential to impact the Preferred Alternative footprint are described in Section 4.17, Hazardous Materials, of the FEIS.

The construction activities and the proposed mitigation for the Preferred Alternative are consistent with the conclusions provided in the original DEIS. As discussed in the FEIS, when the project enters final design, additional information will be known about required right-of-way and acquisitions. At that time, further investigations will be made to characterize the extent and quantity of hazardous material sites impacted by the project.

In summary, the Preferred Alternative footprint has fewer high ranking hazardous material sites within the proposed footprint than Packages 2 or 4. At this stage in the Preferred Alternative development and design process, there are no known hazardous material sites that present sufficient risk such that an alignment would be changed.




# Figure 1 - US 36 I-25 and Pecos St






# Figure 3 - US 36 and Sheridan Boulevard






# Figure 6 - US 36 and Wadsworth Boulevard (Central 0 to 0.1 Mile)








# Figure 7 - US 36 and Wadsworth Boulevard (Central 0.1 to 0.5 Mile)







# Figure 9 - US 36 and Marshall Road


