# DEFINING COLORADO'S ROAD CONDITIONS

**ROAD CLOSED/BLOCKED:** Colorado roads can be closed or temporarily blocked due to adverse weather conditions and incidents like accidents and rockslides. Construction and maintenance activities can cause partial or full closures.

**WET:** Traction may diminish due to wet or freezing roads, and hydroplaning is possible. The additional moisture and possible foggy conditions may also reduce visibility.

**SNOWPACKED:** A road is snowpacked if packed-down snow covers the road. Identifying your traffic lane may be difficult.

**SNOWING AND ICY:** Snow is currently falling and icy/slippery conditions may exist.

**HIGH WIND ADVISORY:** High winds are possible and high-profile and empty-load vehicles should be alert for strong winds.

**HIGH WIND RESTRICTION:** High winds are possible and travel may be restricted for high-profile and empty-load vehicles.

**BLOWING AND/OR DRIFTING SNOW:** May cause poor visibility and snowpacked and icy conditions.

**CHAIN RESTRICTIONS:** Chains must be used when the law is in effect. Colorado has four levels of chain restrictions. The most common restriction requires chains on commercial single drive axle vehicles or on all commercial vehicles. Although rarely implemented, chains can be required on all vehicles when conditions warrant.

**511 UPDATES:** The hotline is updated as new information is available 24/7, 365 days a year.
