


COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION BLOOD DONATION PROGRAM

The Colorado Department of Transportation offers employees the opportunity to contribute to a community cause through the quarterly blood drives held at CDOT. These programs are held with Bonfils Blood Center, the major supplier for the entire state of Colorado. Bonfils provides blood and blood products to more than 115 hospitals and transfusion services throughout the state. One donation, which is one pint of blood collected from one donor, can be used to help save up to three lives.

The program has been in existence since March 1974 and it's volunteers here at CDOT keep it going. You, your spouse, or dependents 17 years of age or older can donate under this program.
