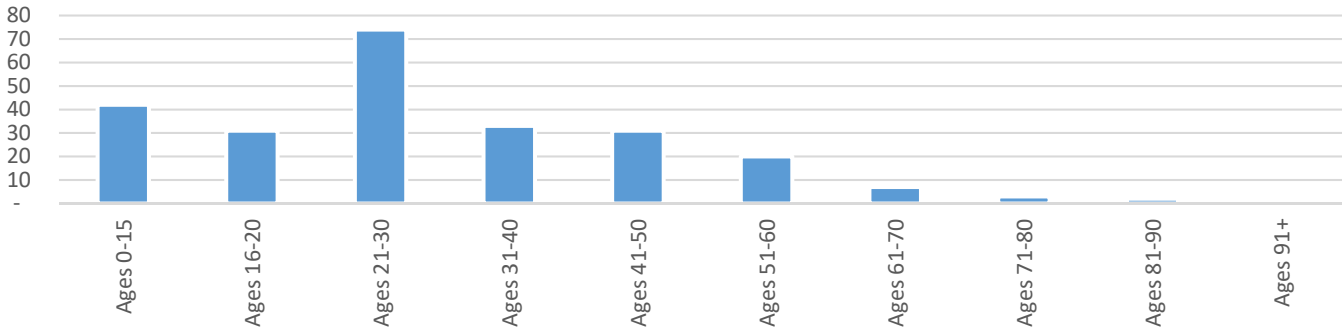

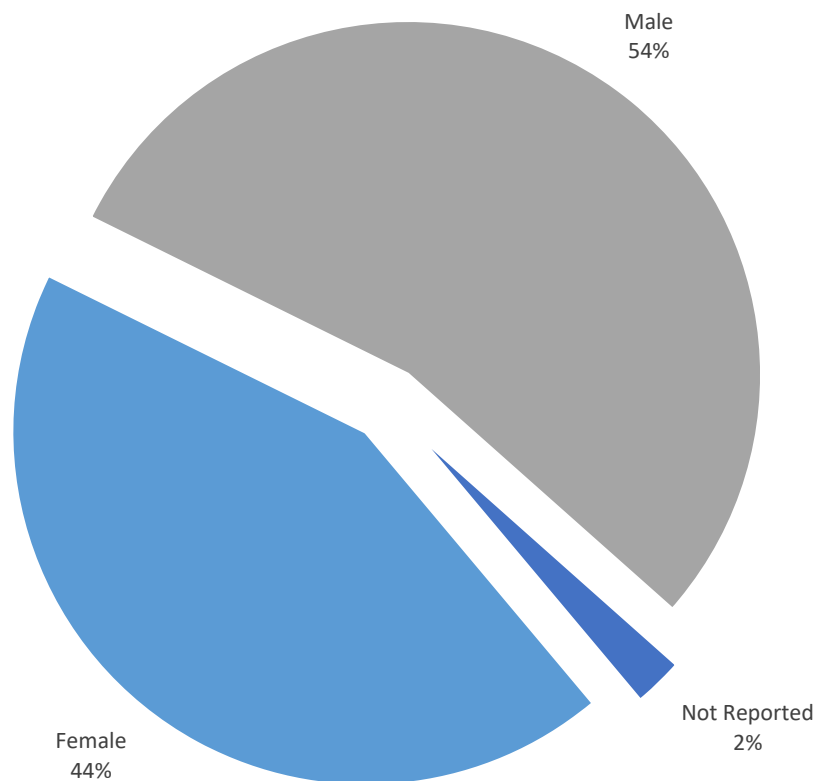

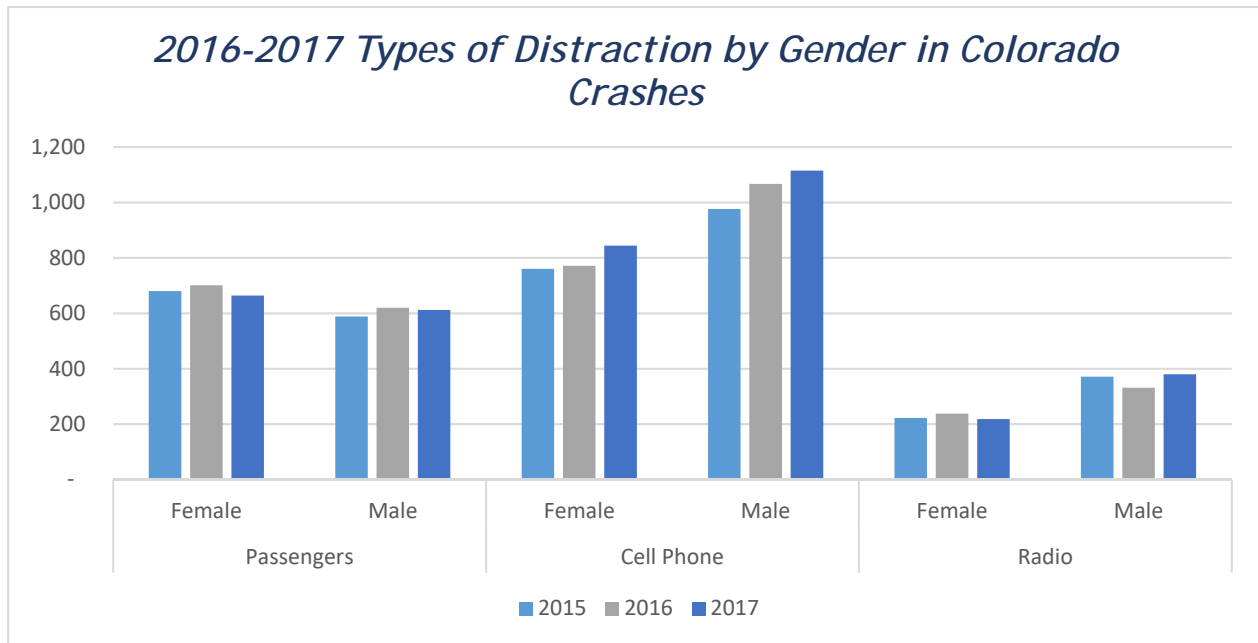

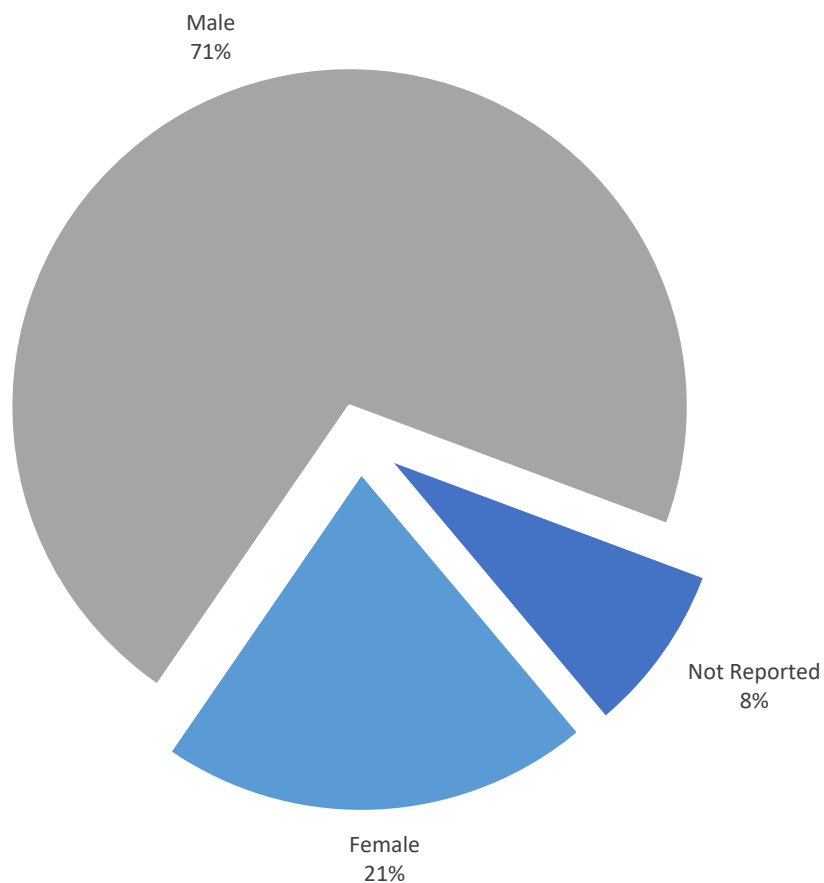

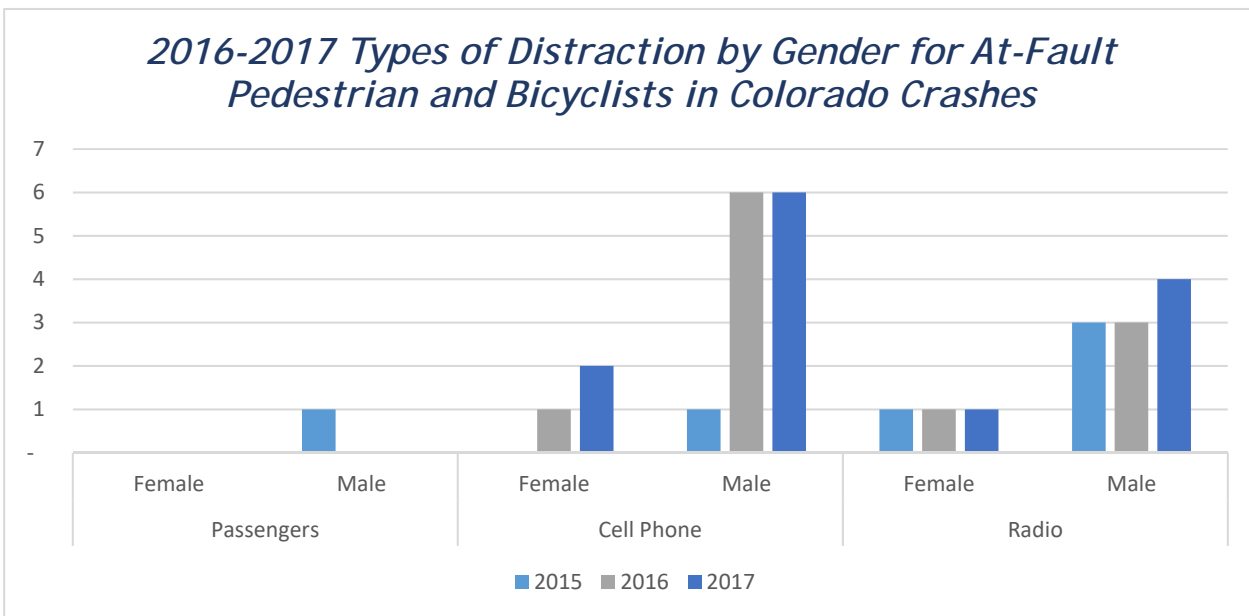

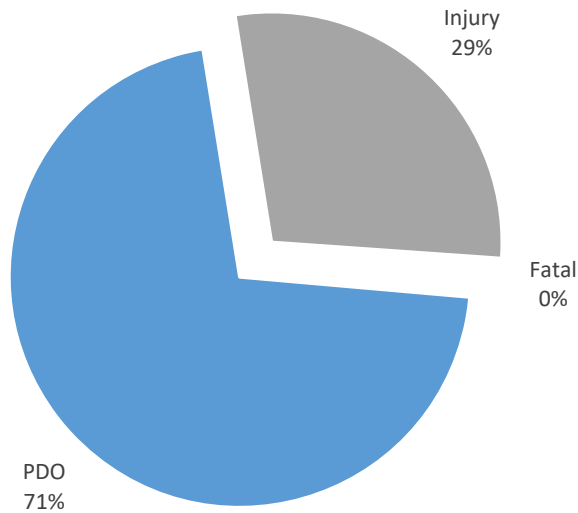

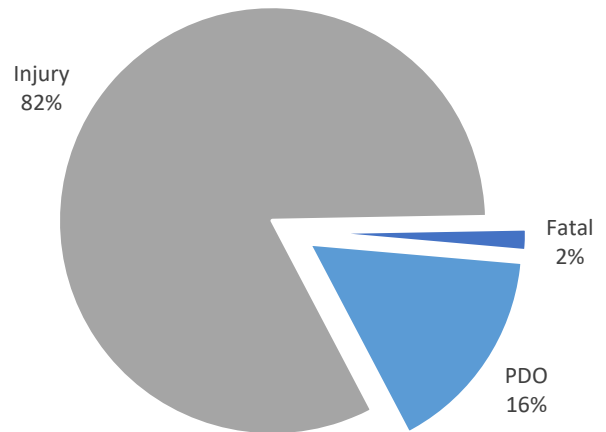

2012-2017 All Distraction Related Crashes Severity



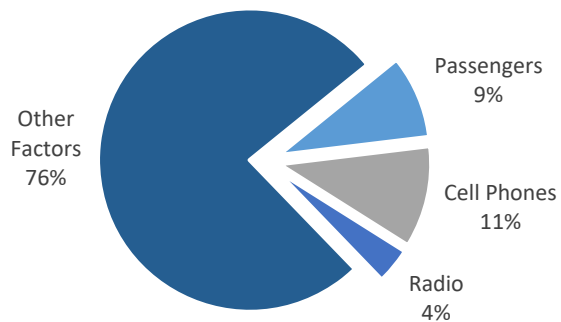
2012-2017 Pedestrian and Bicycle Distraction Related Crashes by Severity



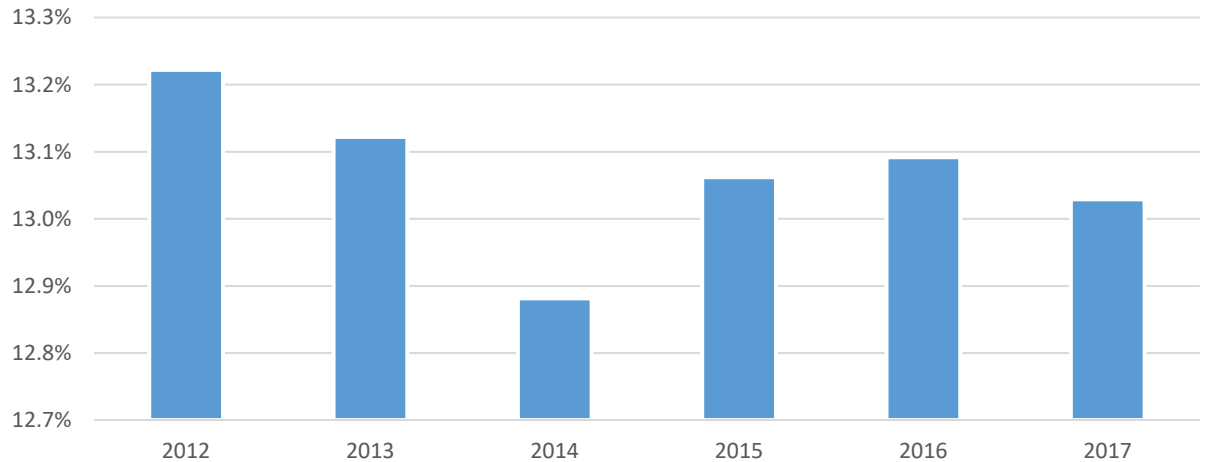

2009-2017 All Distracted Driving in Crashes by Type of Distraction



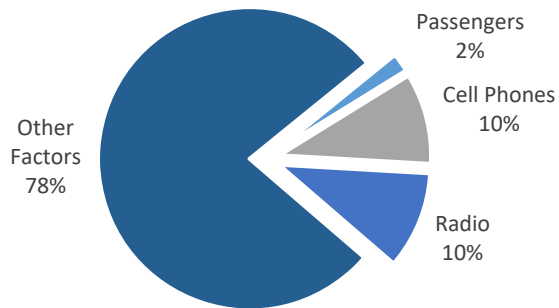
2009-2017 Percentage of Total Colorado All Distracted Driving in Crashes
