## Resolution #BE 20-02-02

Committing a CBE funding match for the Fiscal Year (FY) 2020 Infrastructure for Rebuilding America (INFRA) Discretionary Grant Program to address one CBE eligible structure, I-70 EB over Polk Creek (F-12-AS), as part of the I-70 Vail Pass Safety and Operations Improvements Project.

## Approved by the Colorado Bridge Enterprise Board of Directors on February 20, 2020.

WHEREAS, the Colorado General Assembly created the Colorado Bridge Enterprise (CBE) in C.R.S. 43-4-805 as a government-owned business within the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT or Department) for the business purpose of financing, repairing, reconstructing, and replacing Designated Bridges, defined in C.R.S. 43-4-803(10) as those bridges identified as structurally deficient or functionally obsolete and rated poor; and

**WHEREAS,** the Fixing America's Surface Transportation (FAST) Act authorizes the INFRA program at \$4.5 billion from FY2016 through FY2020, including \$1.0 billion for FY2020, to be awarded by the USDOT on a competitive basis to projects of national or regional significance that meet statutory requirements. (Pub. L. 114-94, December 4, 2015); and

WHEREAS, a Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) was issued by U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT) on January 13, 2020 for the FY 2020 INFRA Discretionary Grant Program; and

**WHEREAS,** applications for the FY 2020 INFRA Discretionary Grant Program; are due to the USDOT by 11:59 PM E.S.T on February 25, 2020; and

**WHEREAS,** highway and bridge projects carried out on the National Highway System (NHS), including projects that add capacity on the Interstate System to improve mobility or projects in a national scenic area are eligible for the FY 2020 INFRA Discretionary Grant Program; and

**WHEREAS,** the USDOT's evaluation of FY 2020 INFRA Discretionary Grant Program applications will be based on key program objectives: supporting economic vitality, leveraging of federal funding, innovation, and performance and accountability; and

**WHEREAS,** CDOT Staff performed an evaluation of potential projects for the Department to submit under a unified grant application and identified two projects that will be submitted for consideration based on the key program objectives; and

**WHEREAS,** CDOT Staff have recommended the I-70 Vail Pass Safety and Operations Improvements Project as a priority candidate for the FY 2020 INFRA Transportation Discretionary Grant Program application; and

**WHEREAS,** the I-70 Vail Pass Safety and Operations Improvements Project scope includes one CBE eligible bridge, I-70 EB over Polk Creek (F-12-AS), the CBE Board is being asked to commit matching funds to address this structure and increase the competitiveness of the Department's application.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** in order to show the Department's financial commitment to the I-70 Vail Pass Safety and Operations Improvements Project, and because a state match is required and enhances the viability of the application, the CBE commits to providing up to a maximum of \$40 million of Bridge Safety Surcharge revenue to be used on CBE eligible structures if the Department's application is awarded a grant by the USDOT.
