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CDOT Wet Weather Monitoring Program

The CDOT Wet Weather Monitoring Program has two purposes:

To characterize highway runoff water quality, through the monitoring of outfalls draining from State Highways and right-of-way. This allows for the extrapolation and prioritization of the relative environmental impacts to CDOT stormwater sewer outfalls.

To evaluate water quality benefits from Best Management Practices (BMPs) for CDOT maintenance facilities. This includes the identification of pollutant loads from maintenance facilities and assessing the removal efficiency of permanent BMPs that can be used at maintenance and highway facilities to control the entry of pollutants into surface water.
