



I-25/Cimarron Interchange Design-Build Project

Public Open House Coming May 26



Initial construction for the Interstate-25/Cimarron Interchange Design-Build Project starts this summer. The community is invited to come learn about the construction details and schedule and view designs of how the interchange will look upon completion. When complete, it will be a high-functioning interchange that safely handles more vehicles and enhances multi-modal travel for those using the I-25/Cimarron interchange and the trail system along the creeks. This project is the second largest transportation project in Colorado Springs' history, behind only COSMIX, rebuilding the "Gateway" from downtown to the mountain communities to the west.
