RE: Standardized Field Sobriety Testing (SFST) Program

Colorado Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) along with the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) and the Colorado District Attorneys Council (CDAC) have made changes to the administering of the recertification process for the SFST program.

As of October 1, 2015, POST will be responsible for coordination and hosting two eight (8) hour SFST instructor updates annually.

CDOT will oversee and approve all SFST standards and curriculum. POST will announce the classes, post them on their training calendar and make them available via the training portal.
